# Why Consider Financial Assistance?

Christian Academy is committed to making Christian Education as affordable as possible. For the 2025-2026 school year over 50% of our Junior Academy students receive tuition support through financial assistance and discount programs provided by our school and the SGO scholarship program provided by the generosity of donors.

# Who May Qualify for Tuition Assistance?

All prospective and enrolled Jr. Academy students may apply. New families may contact the Tuition Assistance Coordinator.

# How do I Qualify for Tuition Assistance?

A third party administrator, FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment (FACTS), is used to determine eligibility. A family's application, along with financial information, goes directly to FACTS. All tuition assistance awards are based on need (as determined by FACTS) and the total amount of assistance available. Tuition assistance awards may vary each year.

# **How do I Apply for Tuition Assistance?**

Create an account at online.factsmgt.com and submit a Tuition Assistance application for your student. FACTS assesses a \$40 fee to submit the Tuition Assistance application. Families must reapply each school year.

**NEW STUDENTS: Application Fee –** A fee of \$100 per Junior Academy student must accompany each application. The application fee is non-refundable.

**RETURNING STUDENTS: Continuous Enrollment Fee –** A non-refundable fee of \$100 per Junior Academy student is due **February 28, 2025**. This fee will be paid in conjunction with the online continuous enrollment process through FACTS. (FACTS refers to this as "Downpayment")

### **TUITION/FEE POLICY**

Tuition and other fees are necessary in order for Christian Academy to fulfill its mission of developing students with a heart for God. In support of this, parents are expected to commit themselves to meet financial obligations promptly in accordance with Biblical stewardship and to comply with the following policy:

**The Continuous Enrollment Fee is non-refundable** unless for any reason Christian Academy does not readmit the student. If parents withdraw their student's enrollment for any reason, the Continuous Enrollment Fee is non-refundable. *(FACTS refers to this as "Downpayment")* 

The school has contracted with FACTS Tuition Management for the processing of all tuition payments. The following payment options are available through FACTS:

- Annual Payment due June 16, 2025.
- Monthly Payments (August through May). A \$50 annual processing fee per agreement is required for using this service and will be automatically drafted from your account by FACTS within 14 days of the agreement being posted to the FACTS system.

A one-month notice must be given for any withdrawals prior to the end of the school year because the hiring of teachers and staff and the ordering of classroom materials are based upon anticipated enrollment. Notice must be provided by completing the Withdrawal Form located in your Web Forms in FACTS Family Portal.

Tuition that becomes two months past due will subject the student to being withheld from attending school.

Because tuition is calculated on an annual basis, no adjustments will be made for absences, holidays or unscheduled closures.

### **TUITION ASSISTANCE**

Tuition assistance awards are based on the family's demonstrated need as determined by a third-party agency (FACTS) that makes financial needs assessments for private and Christian schools. Each award is made for one year only, based on the availability of tuition assistance funds. FACTS charges a \$40 fee to submit the tuition assistance application.

### **ADDITIONAL FEES**

### Missed Payment Fee

Missed payment fees are assessed by FACTS if payment is not received as scheduled.

### After-hour Fee

An after-hour fee of \$2.00 per minute per student will be charged beginning at 12 PM (half-day program), 4 PM (full-day program), and 6 PM (After-School Care Program).

### **Returned Check Fee**

A \$25 returned check fee will be charged on all returned checks.

### Miscellaneous Expenses

During the course of the school year, other expenses may be incurred for various services or activities. Notice of at least two weeks will be given before such a fee is due, and participation in the activity is typically optional.

### AFTER-SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM

Families may opt to register to attend the After-School Care program from 4 PM to

Registration opens in Spring 2025.

Cost is \$1400 per school year per student (\$700/semester), scheduled through FACTS.

An after-hour fee of \$2.00 per minute per student will be charged beginning at 6 PM.

Withdrawals from the After-School Care program must be made at the change in semester. Notice should be provided in writing to the Business Office at least one month in advance.
