ACADEMICS

ELEMENTARY

Elementary is a time of discovery, amazement and excitement as students begin their life-long journey of learning. Christian Academy believes in a traditional Christian education curriculum focusing on core subjects such as reading, writing, vocabulary, social studies, science, math and Bible. Special areas include spiritual formation, music, art, technology, library and physical education, adding depth and great interest at each grade level.



MIDDLE SCHOOL

Middle school is a time of transition, a time of spiritual, academic, emotional and physical growth. Our dedicated teachers guide their students through a challenging academic environment with great expertise and grace. Core subjects include math, science, literature, language arts, history and Bible. These classes are complemented by additional studies in various areas including technology, physical education, art, Spanish, band, choir and orchestra as well as others.



HIGH SCHOOL

High school is a time of preparation and definition in each student's life as he or she moves toward independence. Christian Academy celebrates the drive, ambition, leadership qualities and creativity of its students. Our graduates are well prepared to live out their faith no matter what their next steps include.





JR. ACADEMY

The goal of our junior academy (preschool) programs is to stimulate the students physical, mental, emotional and social development while maintaining a strong spiritual emphasis. The philosophy of our scripture-based curriculum is that young children learn best by doing. With the understanding that play is their “work,” a balance of child-initiated and teacher-directed activities help to prepare the children for future physical development as well as spiritual and academic growth.



3-YEAR-OLD PROGRAM

Students must be 3-years-old by August 1, of the academic school year and must be completely toilet trained in order to be accepted into the program.

The 3-year-old junior academy (preschool) program is intended to introduce little ones to a classroom environment and encourage social development as they grow and mature.

4-YEAR-OLD PROGRAM

The 4-Year-Old junior academy (preschool) program introduces students to the basics of a kindergarten readiness program.



The full-day junior academy (preschool) program is available for students, Monday-Friday from 7 a.m.- 4 p.m. A separate junior academy after-school care program will be offered from 4-6 p.m. at an additional cost for families who choose to register.

PROVIDENCE

Providence School is designed to accommodate children with a primary diagnosis of Down syndrome. Students must be ambulatory and not considered medically fragile. Speech and occupational therapists will provide consultation to teachers regarding student educational needs and individual/group therapy on a weekly/biweekly basis. Additional individual therapy may be provided at school, independent from what the school is providing and at the parent's expense. A working relationship will be maintained with Christian Academy and Down Syndrome of Louisville. Acceptance into Providence School is based on an application and interview as well as an evaluation of a student's current level of development. Providence school is the only non-profit school in the Kentuckiana area with a vision for offering preschool-12th grade integrated educational opportunities for children with Down syndrome.

JUNIOR ACADEMY

Junior academy can accommodate up to four students with Down syndrome. Additional support will be provided in classrooms as needed. A Providence School team member will work with teachers and children to promote spiritual, cognitive, adaptive, language, motor and self-help skills. A total inclusion approach will be used. A Family Service Plan/FSP will be written with each family specific to the needs of their child each year.

ELEMENTARY - HIGH SCHOOL

Providence School will have a specialized teacher and assistants to modify curriculum and provide support to students within the classroom and in small group settings. Specialized curriculum and classroom modifications will meet the individual needs of students. A Family Service Plan/FSP will be written with each family specific to the needs of their child each year. Inclusion into classrooms will promote cognitive, adaptive, language, social and spiritual goals.



FAQS

Is there an application deadline for applying?

Christian Academy School System uses a rolling admissions model - continuous enrollment. Applications are accepted throughout the year for all campuses and all grade levels. Annually, on April 1 (or the closest business date), we begin accepting applications one-and-a-half years in advance of the school year of interest for all grade levels.

Is your school accredited?

Christian Academy of Louisville is accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI), Cognia, the Kentucky Non-Public School Commission and is certified by the State of Kentucky.

Christian Academy of Indiana is accredited by the Indiana Department of Education, the Association of Christian School International (ACSI) and Cognia.

What grade levels are offered at each campus?

Both of our campuses, English Station and Indiana, offer junior academy (preschool) through 12th Grade.

Do both campuses offer junior academy (preschool) programs?

Yes, each of our campuses offers junior academy (preschool).

Are there before-school and after-school programs available?

Yes, although programs vary by campus. Please contact the Christian Academy Business Office at (502) 244-3225 for more information.

Do students wear uniforms?

Yes, students kindergarten through 12th grade wear uniforms, although the dress code and uniform vendors vary according to grade level. Junior academy students do not wear uniforms. For more information about the dress code for your school and campus of interest, please ask an Admissions Coordinator.

Do you have a parent organization?

Each campus has an active PTO. Parent volunteers are very much appreciated in our school system.

Does your Indiana Campus participate in the Indiana School Choice Scholarship program?

STATEMENT OF FAITH

WE BELIEVE...

The Bible is the only inspired, inerrant Word of God that is sufficient, necessary, authoritative and clear. (1)

In one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. (2)

God, in His sovereignty, offers redemption and restoration to all who confess and repent from their sin, who seek His mercy and grace and humbly ask for His forgiveness through Jesus Christ. (3)

Jesus Christ is God Himself, came to earth in the flesh, was born of a virgin and lived a sinless life. He died a substitutionary and atoning death on the cross. He arose bodily from the grave and ascended into heaven where He sits at the right hand of God and will return in victory to rule forever. (4)

The Holy Spirit convicts of sin, regenerates to new life, indwells every Christian, helps in weakness and intercedes on behalf of believers and churches in prayer and empowers believers to live a fruitful Christian life. (5)

All people are created in God's image and being descended from Adam inherited a sinful nature and are totally unable to save themselves from the natural consequences of sin. Every human is a person deserving of compassion, love, kindness, respect and dignity. (6)

All people are saved and justified by faith in the shed blood of Jesus Christ and by accepting Him as Lord and Savior are born again by the Holy Spirit and become children of God. There is a spiritual unity of all believers in our Lord Jesus Christ. (7)

The statement of faith does not exhaust the extent of our faith. The Bible itself, as the inspired and infallible Word of God that speaks with final authority concerning truth, morality and the proper conduct of humankind, is the sole and final source of all that we believe. For purposes of doctrine, practice, policy and discipline, the Superintendent, subject to review by the Board of Directors as appropriate, is the school system's final interpretive authority on the Bible's meaning and application.
