

CFSI Scholarship Applications for the Class of 2025

You will need to create an account to apply. There are two separate applications. One is for the "General Scholarships" and the other is for the Lilly Scholarship.

The Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship will provide all funding necessary for awarding as many as two scholarships in both Clark and Floyd Counties. The scholarship provides full tuition to any four-year accredited Indiana college or university, public or private. Additionally, an annual stipend is awarded for books and required fees.
