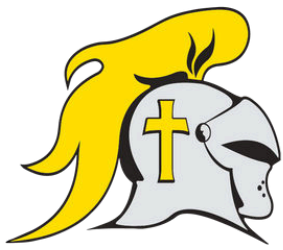

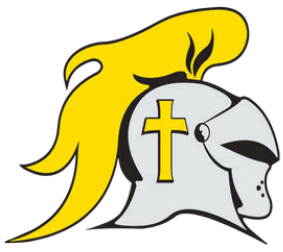
Please join us for our next Grandparents Club meeting on February 19 at 9:00 AM. It's a great time to connect and hear more about the wonderful things happening on campus.
