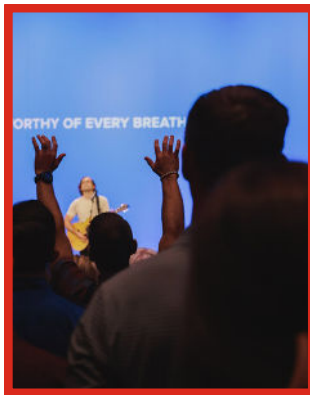
The first few weeks of school have been full of joy and excitement! We are excited to see how our students grow academically and spiritually this year!



The rain did not stop our seniors from welcoming families on the first day of school! From new memories and friendships to new opportunities and challenges, we know this will be a year to remember.

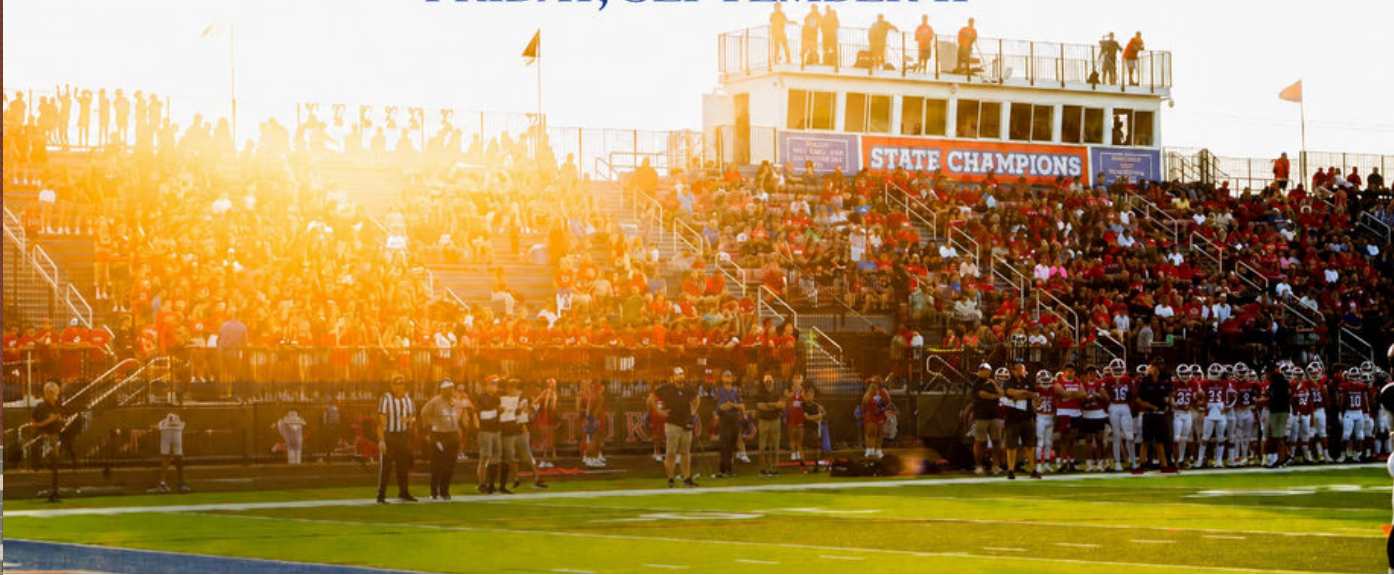

My grandfather, James E. Farmer, was Christian Academy's first superintendent. In 1976, he helped start the school in a church basement with the belief that faith and academics are not rivals. He laid the foundation for the school system and secured the first accreditation on our Rock Creek Campus.

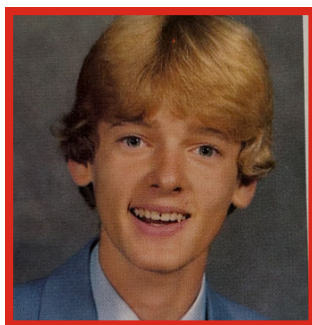
My journey began as a student in the first graduating class of 1982. Decades later, I returned as the principal of the Southwest Campus for two years. During my tenure, we focused on preparing the campus for growth by expanding learning areas, strengthening athletic programs and improving the grounds.

I am currently working on an Advanced Program curriculum in Hong Kong and an International Baccalaureate project in Taipei that begins this fall. The legacy that began with my grandfather continues today in my son, Kade Schooling, a former Southwest student, who recently earned a Fulbright scholarship to Taipei Medical University.

My favorite memories as the principal of the Southwest Campus include seeing students grow spiritually, whether praying for the first time during Chapel or showing sportsmanship on the court, and achieving the Southern Association Accreditation, just as my grandfather did at the Rock Creek Campus. During my two years, I focused on "rising up and building" (Nehemiah 2:18). We expanded the library and athletic programs, and strengthened the school body by hiring dedicated, believing teachers.

The physical changes of the school system have been significant. We grew from the small Rock Creek Campus with limited facilities to expanded media centers and athletic fields. But the mission remains the same. Based on Luke 2:52, the focus on wisdom, stature, and favor with God and man continues through generational blessings.

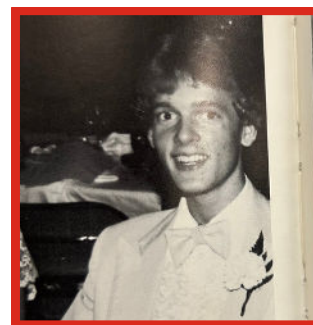

CHRISTMAS AT CAL

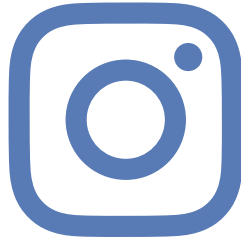
