## **Administration of Prescription Medication**

The Health Room is happy to administer prescription medications to students. A Medication Administration Release Form (link provided <u>HERE</u>) must be completed, signed by the parent and brought in with the medicine. All prescription medications must be in the original container with the physician's name, prescription, and dosage instructions label intact. Parents are responsible for providing all information needed for proper administration of medications. Christian Academy will not administer medications past their expiration date. Medication improperly labeled will not be administered. In addition, a new form must be completed if there are any changes to the original instructions.

## **Administration of Over-the-Counter Medications**

The Health Room provides the following over-the-counter medications:

- Acetaminophen
- Ibuprofen
- Benadryl
- Tums
- Sudafed
- Cough drops

These medications can only be administered by the Health Room staff if parents have given permission by completing the Student Medical Information form in FACTS Family Portal. This form can completed by clicking HERE.

\*\*\* Students are not allowed to self-carry any type of medication with the exception of Epinephrine pens and inhalers once students have reached Middle School. Elementary students are not allowed to self-carry ANY medication of any kind.
