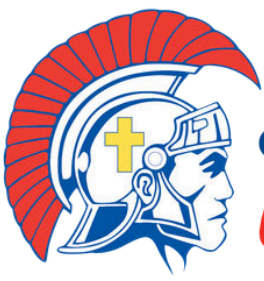


# Junior Academy Happenings...

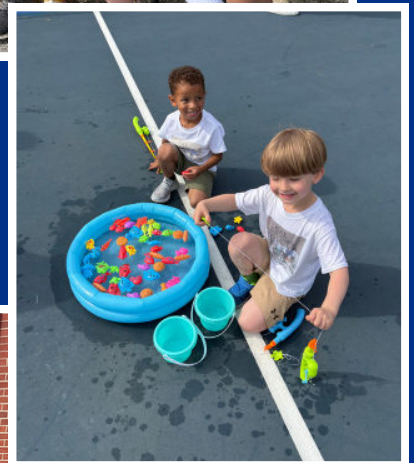
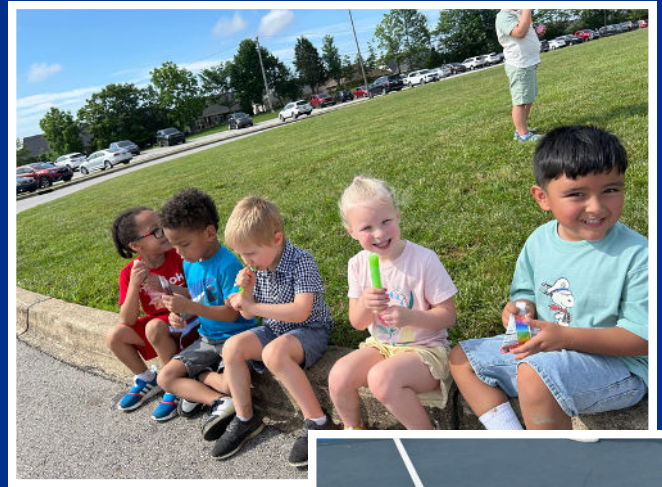

## Last Day Lawn Party

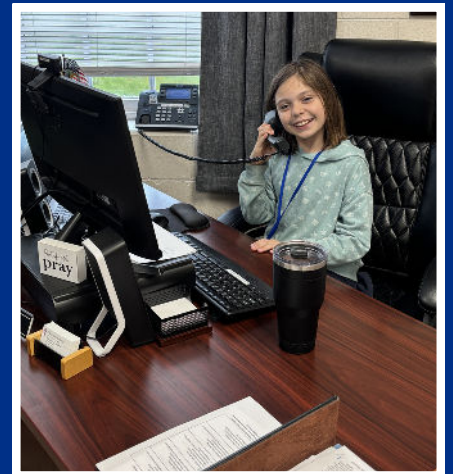
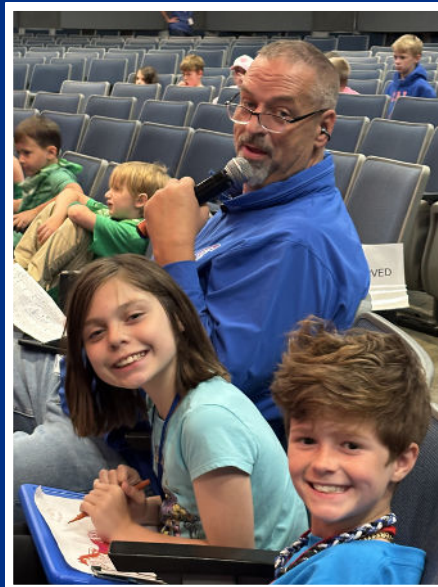
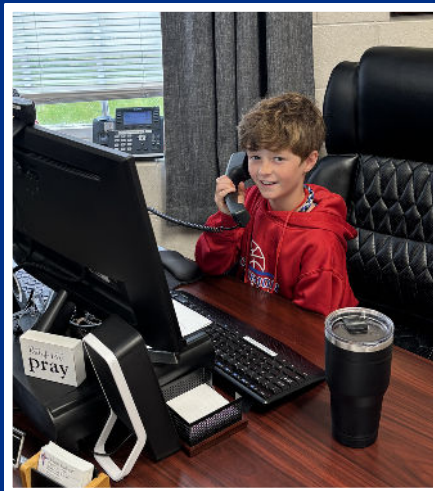

## Elementary Happenings... Principal for a Day

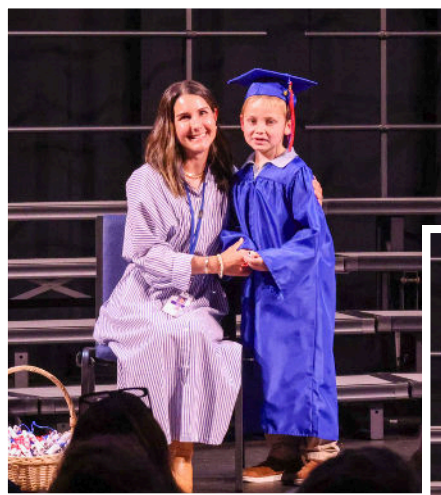

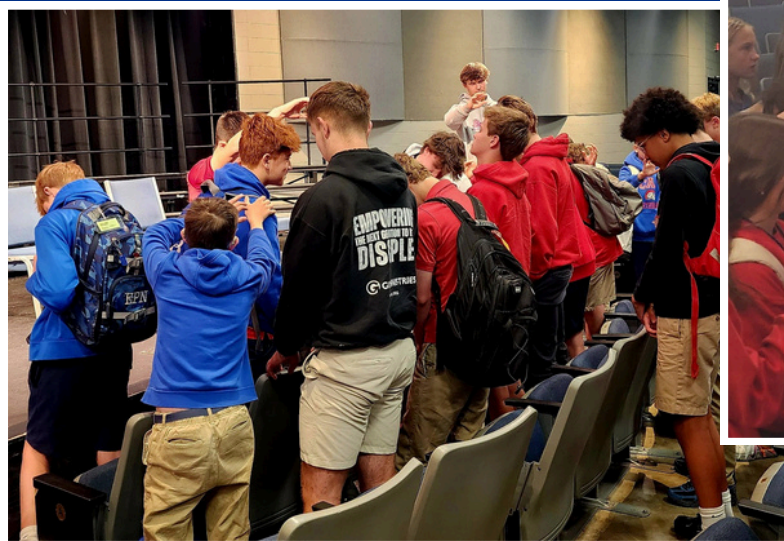




# Middle School Happenings...

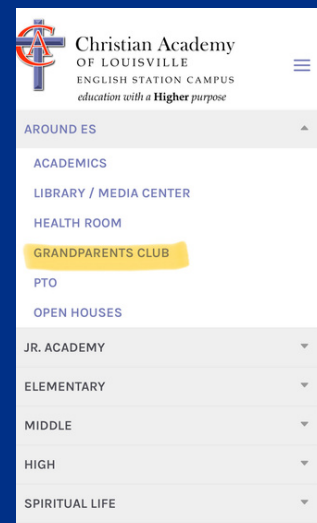
