## Girls basketball falls just short against No. 4 Pikeville

The varsity girls basketball team nearly pulled off an upset of fourth-ranked Pikeville on Saturday in the Raatz Fence Classic.

The Centurions led in the fourth quarter but couldn't close the deal late in a 62-55 loss to the Panthers, who are undefeated against in-state opponents this season.

CAL moved to 10-6 on the year and will play in the Louisville Invitational Classic this week.

The Centurions host the winner of Assumption and Bullitt East in their first game of the tournament on Tuesday at 6:30 p.m.

# Varsity boys basketball can't dig out of early hole against North Oldham

The varsity boys basketball team fell behind early and couldn't close the gap in a 70-54 loss to visiting North Oldham on Jan. 16.

The Mustangs knocked down four 3s in the opening period to take a 20-6 advantage going into the second quarter.

CAL's offense began clicking in the second period – including a 10 point quarter by BB Washington – but North Oldham remained hot from the field to take a 41-25 lead at halftime.

CAL made up ground in the third quarter, but a fourth quarter surge from the Mustangs buried the comeback attempt.

The Centurions travel to Trinity this Tuesday before hosting Ballard in a 28th District matchup on Friday. CAL beat the Bruins for the first time in school history earlier this month.

## 8th boys basketball goes 1-1

The eighth grade boys basketball team split a pair of games last week.

On Jan. 16, the Centurion defense stifled Shelby County West in a 44-20 at CAL.
