



HS swimming qualifies for semi-state in eight events Girls finish 5th, boys 9th at region meet

The high school swim team had a strong showing at the KHSAA Region Five meet last Friday and Saturday at Ralph Wright Natatorium.

The girls team finished in fifth place with 146 points. The boys team finished ninth with 59 points.

CAL had a number of standout performances, culminating in eight semi-state qualifications.

Kate Braeger

qualified in two events as an individual by winning the 200 intermediate medley with a time of 2:03.30 and placing second in the 100 backstroke with a time of 54.51.

Raegan Guilford was the only other individual qualifier from the girls team with a ninth place finish in the 500 freestyle.

The relay team of Kate Braeger, Eme Brooks, Rebekah Hammond and Rae-

gan Guilford placed second in the 200 freestyle relay with a time of 1:45.84.

Guilford, Hammond, Braeger and Brooks teamed up again to place third in the 400 freestyle relay with a time of 3:53.33.

Jack Borrage qualified for semi-state in two events, taking second in the 100 breaststroke with a time of 1:01.04 and third in the 200 IM with a time of 1:59.09.

Aden Braeger finished sixth in the 500 freestyle with a time of 5:10.86.

The semi-state

meet is set to take place on Feb. 8 at Ralph Wright Natatorium.



Varsity boys basketball splits two district contests

The varsity boys basketball team went 1-2 last week, including a split against two 28th District opponents.

On Tuesday, the Centurions fell 64-41 on the road at North Oldham.

Ten Centurions broke into the scoring column, but only freshman Man Robinson exceeded six points, with a team high 11.

CAL bounced back with an 85-65 win at KCD in both teams' first intra-district

matchup of the season.

Junior JJ Washington had a remarkable day from the field, scoring 32 points on 13-of-20 shooting, including 4-for-6 from beyond the arc. Junior Roland Swan and freshman Boogie Cook also finished with 15 and 14 points, respectively for CAL.

The Centurions hit the road again for another district matchup on Friday at Ballard and fell 84-67.

The varsity girls basketball team had a 1-3 week last week, including a 1-1 split of two games against 28th District foes.

The Centurions began the week with a 78-54 loss at Mercer County on Monday.

Freshman Candice Smith led CAL with 21 points, followed by seventh grader Kathryn Cline with 13.

CAL bounced back to defeat Kentucky Country Day 55-38 on Thursday night in the team's first district matchup of the season.

The Centurions got a significant boost from its middle schoolers in the win, as Cline led the team with 13 points and eighth grader Brooklyn McAllister chipped in 11 of her own.

CAL couldn't keep the momentum rolling the next

night, as a trip to Ballard ended in a 75-41 defeat.

Smith paced CAL with 17 points in the loss.

The Centurions rounded out a busy week with a 46-32 loss in a defensive battle at Pleasure Ridge Park on Saturday.

Cline was the lone Centurion in double figures scoring with 11 points, including 6-of-8 shooting from the charity stripe.

CAL will host Oldham County on Thursday this week before traveling to Bullitt East on Saturday.
