



Varsity boys basketball notches top 10 win

The varsity boys basketball team went 1-1 against a pair of highly-ranked Seventh Region foes last week.

On Tuesday, the Centurions couldn't keep up with No. 7 St. Xavier in a fast-paced 83-71 defeat.

CAL shot an efficient 8-for-17 from beyond the arc, but turnover and rebounding woes helped the Tigers escape with a win.

On Thursday, CAL rebounded to roll past

10th-ranked DuPont Manual 75-55.

The Centurions lost to the Crimsons by 31 points just three weeks earlier at the Louisville Invitational Tournament, but CAL flipped the script early in the rematch.

CAL began the game on a 14-4 run and used a surge in the closing minutes of the second quarter to build a 36-16 lead by halftime. Nolan Wahl

Four HS swimmers qualify for state meet

CAL competed at the Fifth Region swim meet last weekend at the University of Louisville's Ralph Wright Natatorium.

The state meet field is incomplete as of Monday afternoon, but the Centurions have already automatically qualified for the meet in three events behind stellar performances.

The 200-yard medley relay and 200-yard freestyle relay – both of which were made up of Sydney Perkins, Caroline Wilson, Jillian Beardsley and Rae-gan Guilford – finished

high enough in the region meet to punch their ticket to Lexington in a couple weeks.

Perkins, a University of Connecticut commit, also earned an automatic bid in the 100-yard breast-stroke.

CAL fell to top-ranked Sacred Heart 66-40 on Tuesday then 67-54 to Manual on Thursday before besting the Bruins 68-55 on Friday evening.

In Friday's contest, CAL jumped out to a 12-0 lead just over two minutes into the first quarter.

However, the Centurions

didn't make a field goal the remainder of the period, as Ballard cut the lead to 13-7 going into the second quarter.

CAL's offense regained its footing in a 25-point second quarter, and the Centurions led 38-25 at halftime.

The Centurions remained in control the entire second half and cruised to victory to improve to 1-0 in 28th District play.
