



Braeger wins state title, sets two school records HS swimming competes in the six events at state meet

The HS swim team had a strong showing at the KHSAA state meet last weekend at the University of Kentucky's Lancaster Aquatic Center.

The Centurions competed in six events as a team and reached the finals in five.

Junior Kate Braeger had an outstanding day, winning the state championship in the 200 individual medley and finishing second in the 100 backstroke. Braeger's times of 1:59.75 (200 IM) and 0:53.53 (100 backstroke) are new school

records.

Braeger also competed alongside Jillian Beardsley, Rebekah Hammond and Raegan Guilford on the 200 and 400 freestyle relays, both of which finished in eighth place.

The girls team tallied 81 points total, good for 12th place overall.

Jack Borruga represented the boys team in two events. The sophomore took 16th place in the 200 IM and 19th in the 100 breaststroke.



HS/MS archery nearing end of 2024-25 campaign

The CAL middle and high school archery teams have pieced together a stellar season to date, finishing near the top of multiple tournaments with several standout individual performances.

HS recently took second place at the Ramsey Archery Tournament on Feb. 8.

Eighth grader Gabe Fletcher earned 3rd place in

Varsity girls basketball wins two to end regular season

The varsity girls basketball team capped the 2024-25 regular season with a 2-0 week.

On Thursday, CAL put together its best defensive effort of the season in a 49-14 win at North Oldham.

Nine Centurions scored in a balanced offensive performance, led by freshman Candice Smith's 11 points.

CAL turned around and defeated Jeffersontown 61-33 in its regular season finale on Friday.

The Centurions jumped

out to a 20-point lead by halftime at 33-13 and coasted to victory in the second half.

CAL entered the postseason with a 9-20 record. After a tough start to the season, CAL won seven of its last 15 games down the stretch.

The Centurions beat Eastern 42-36 in the 28th District semifinals this Monday (write-up to come next week) and will play at Ballard in the finals this Wednesday at 7 p.m.

J-Town pulls away from varsity boys basketball late

The varsity boys basketball team rounded out the regular season with an 82-68 defeat to visiting Jefferson-town last Friday.

CAL trailed 49-47 after three quarters, but the Sixth Region contending Chargers exploded for 32 points in the final period to pull away.

Sophomore Guy Turner had a strong day shooting the ball, knocking down 4-of-6 3-point attempts on his way to a team-high 14 points. Junior JJ Washington (14 points), junior Roland

Swan (12) and freshman Man Robinson (11).

The Centurions finish the regular season with a 12-14 record.

CAL will play Eastern in the 28th District semifinals at Ballard on Tuesday at 7:30 p.m. The winner will advance to play in the championship on Thursday at 7 p.m.

The Centurions and Eagles met earlier this month, with CAL prevailing 80-56 behind an impressive second half effort on Feb. 8.
