Varsity swimming takes seventh at state

Perkins wins 100 breaststroke, breaks own school record

The varsity swimming team had a strong showing at the state meet at the University of Kentucky this past Saturday, taking seventh as a team with 114 points.

CAL's score was boosted by five top five finishes, led by a state championship effort by Sydney Perkins in the 100-yard breaststroke.

Perkins' time of 1:02.16 set a new school record, topping the record she set at the state first round just a week earlier.

The senior also took third place in the 100-yard free-style.

The relay team of Perkins, Caroline Wilson, Jillian Beardsley and Raegan Guilford also had a successful day.

The team finished third in the 200-yard medley relay and fifth in the 200-yard freestyle relay.

Caroline Wilson also took fifth in the 50-yard freestyle to round out the day for CAL.







Varsity boys basketball finishes regular season with win Will play Ballard in district semis

The varsity boys basketball season concluded its regular season with a 57-48 win over Jeffersontown last Tuesday.

The Centurions overcame a slow shooting night from beyond the arc to claw its way to its 16th win of the season.

CAL went just 3-for-18 from 3 but led nearly the entire game by single digits and ultimately pulled away with an 8-0 run to begin the fourth quarter.

Connor Hodge led the Centurions with 13 points in a balanced effort

offensively that saw four players finish with at least 11 points.

CAL will look to continue the momentum on Monday in the 28th District semifinals against Ballard at Eastern.

The Centurions had never defeated Ballard entering this season, but CAL has bested the Bruins twice this season.

The winner of that game will go on to face the winner of Eastern vs. Kentucky Country Day in the tournament championship on Wednesday.
