### Varsity boys basketball can't complete comeback in district finals

The varsity boys basketball fell 76-72 to Ballard in the 28th District finals last Thursday.

CAL got off to a slow start, and the Bruins jumped out to an 18-0 lead late in the first quarter.

However, the Centurions close out the opening period on a quick 7-0 spurt to cut into the deficit.

CAL continued to fight back and took a 32-31 advance just past the midpoint of the second quarter.

CAL held a 36-34 lead at the end of a roller coaster of a first half.

Ballard responded early in the second half and gained a 46-40 advantage by the midpoint of the third quarter.

The Bruins led by double digits for much of the fourth quarter before a CAL run in the closing minute of the game capped by a 3 at the final buzzer got the Centurions back within four points.

CAL beat Eastern 66-46 earlier in the week to reach the district finals matchup.

CAL led 32-24 at halftime and stretched its lead out to 52-33 by the end of the third quarter before coasting the rest of the way to victory.

Seven Centurions scored at least six points, led by JJ Washington and Guy Turner with 13 points each. Washington and Roland Swan were named to the all-tournament team following the championship game.

CAL moves on to face Trinity on the road in the 7th Region semifinals on Tuesday at 7 p.m.





#### Varsity volleyball commemorates state title with ring ceremony

The varsity volleyball team celebrated a 32-5 season and the first 2A state championship in program history on Thursday last week during a ring ceremony with family and friends.

CAL defeated Taylor County 3-1 on Sept. 20 in Owensboro to win the title.

CAL finished the season ranked sixth in the state for sets won

and seventh in sets played.

Freshman Kayleigh Rogers finished 24th in the state in kills, and seniors Kate Chase and Ella Baker finished 33rd in blocks and fifth in assists, respectively.

With a deep bench of underclassmen, CAL is primed to make another run at a 2A state title next season.

## Varsity girls basketball falls in region quarterfinals

The varsity girls basketball season came to a close with a 79-26 loss at Sacred Heart in the 7th Region quarterfinals on March 2.

The Centurions jumped out to a 13-9 lead against the four-time defending state champions but couldn't sustain the early momentum.

CAL qualified for the 7th Region tournament by finishing as the runner up in the night. 28th District tournament.

The Centurions defeated Eastern 42-36 in the district semifinals last Monday to clinch their spot in the region tournament.

CAL built a 20-11 lead by halftime behind a strong defensive effort, then held off an Eagle comeback attempt late.

Sophomore Lydia Wallace had a strong day, pacing the Centurions in both points (11) and rebounds (seven).

CAL advanced to play Ballard in the district championship last] Wednesday

CAL held a slim 14-12 lead at the end of the first quarter and sat within a point midways through the second period. However, Ballard closed

the first half on a 6-0 run to take a 29-23 advantage going into the locker room, then the Bruins dominated the second half on their way to a 69-36 win.

CAL finished the year with a 10-22 record and will graduate one senior in guard Katie Hendricks.
