



Varsity baseball collects two big wins

Varsity baseball traveled to KCD last Tuesday to open up the 2024 district slate.

Strong pitching and defense left the game scoreless after two innings.

Logan York and Jackson Watkins reached base to start the third inning, and CAL broke through on an error in right field on a Trey Tipton fly ball that allowed both runners to score. Tipton came around to score on a wild pitch to push the CAL lead 3-0.

CAL pushed across runs in every inning from that point on.

Eli Deming singled to lead off the fourth inning and came around to score to make the score 4-0.

After the Bearcats got a run back in the bottom of the frame, Cameron Combs opened the fifth inning with a double to left field, and courtesy runner

Trevor Daugherty scored on a single by Nathan King to make the score 5-1.

A single by Watkins and back-to-back doubles by Tipton and Combs pushed the CAL lead to 7-1 after six innings.

In the seventh inning, CAL blew the game open with extra base hits from Crawford, York and Combs to help plate five more insurance runs to run the score up to 12-1, which was ultimately the final score.

Combs delivered a strong outing on the mound, going 6 innings and giving up 3 hits, 0 earned runs while striking out six. Cobe Ross finished the game by striking out the side in the seventh.

CAL traveled to play Shelby County on Friday night.


CAL stayed hot out of the gate, as Tipton singled to left field and scored on a

double to left field by Combs. Combs scored on a single by King to give CAL a 2-0 lead after one inning.

Hits by Watkins and Tipton helped push the lead to 3-0 in the second inning.

Watkins lined a single to right field and used his speed to make a full trip around the bases when the ball slipped

Thomas Nelson scored in the bottom of the frame to stretch its lead back out to 6-3, and CAL couldn't answer in the seventh.




by the outfielder to put the Centurions in front 4-0 in the fourth inning.
