Varsity baseball wins a pair in Vero Beach, FL

Varsity baseball traveled to Vero Beach to play over Spring Break, going 2-3 against teams from across the US.

Game one was on Tuesday, with CAL losing 7-3 to Preble Varsity Green from Wisconsin.

Preble got the early lead, and CAL was not able to catch up.

David Haire took the loss for CAL. The hurler went three and one-third innings, giving up seven runs on four hits, striking out one, and walking seven. Hale, Crawford, and Overstreet pitched in relief.

On Wednesday, the Centurions got on the board in the top of the first inning against Great Crossing in the first of two games on the day.

However, the lead was short-lived, as the Warhawks scored three in the bottom of the first and never relinquished the lead, winning 15-6 in 6 innings.

Trey Tipton started the game for CAL,

giving up seven hits and eight runs (seven earned) over four innings, striking out five and walking four. Crawford and Gibson threw in relief. CAL fared much better in the second game of the day, winning 13-1 against Chicago Christian.

CAL got on the board in the top of the first inning after Kaden Crawford tripled, scoring one run, and Trey Tipton hit a sacrifice fly, scoring two runs.

The Centurions continued the scoring with six runs on four hits in the top of the third inning.

Trevor Daugherty earned the win, surrendering only five hits and one run (zero earned) over five innings, striking out three and walking two.

CAL's bats were hot on Thursday night in their game against the Ketchikan Kings from Alaska.

Tipton and Hale both collected four hits in four at bats, as



CAL defeated Ketchikan 12-0. CAL piled up 14 hits in the game.

Wilt led the Centurions with three runs batted in from the number eight spot in the lineup.

Alex Daugherty earned his first varsity win in his first varsity start for the Centurions.

The hurler allowed two hits and zero

runs over six innings, striking out five and walking five.

Despite leading by as many as four runs, the Centurions fell to Montini Catholic 10-5 on Friday.

Eli Depugh took the loss for CAL. The starting pitcher went four innings, surrendering seven runs (five earned) on 10 hits, striking out none, and walking four. Combs and Overstreet came in for relief.

Cameron Combs and Kaden Crawford were a force together in the lineup, as they each collected two hits for the Centurions.


