



Varsity track & field runs at Male Girls finish fourth with 14 point scorers

After a couple weeks off due to Spring Break and weather-related cancellations, the varsity track and field team returned to competition under sunny skies at the Johnny Conn Invitational at Male High School this past Saturday.

The girls team continued to build momentum, placing fourth overall in a talented slate of 22 teams from across the region.

Showing their breadth of talent, the Centurions had 11 different individual point scorers including Taylor Touche (100m), Ava Moore (100m), Ella Mast (100 hurdles, 400m, triple jump), Kelsea Burkhead (300 hurdles), Kylie Burkhead (800m), Anabelle Plummer

(1,600m), Kinsley Cordrey (3,200m), Kylie Moore (high jump), Addi Pearce (high jump), Megan Bobnar (long jump, triple jump) and Lena Hall (shot put). Three girls relay teams scored points, including the 4x800 (Burkhead, Burkhead, Neher, Wearsch), 4x200 (Touche, Moore, Turoso, Mast) and 4x400 (Burkhead, Burkhead, Neher, Burkhead).

The boys team was led by Samuel Herbig who scored points for his team in the grueling double of 1,600 and 3,200. Elijah Dale earned points in the pole vault, and Addison Page won the unified long jump. The boys 4x100 relay (Moskovich, Nagy, Neuner, Stoner) also turned in an impressive perfor-

mance earning points for their squad.

This Tuesday, the Centurions will travel to North Oldham High School for an all-comers meet. The meet includes a reduced slate of events and promises to be finished by 7:30 p.m., so if you plan to attend, keep an eye on the time.

On Friday and Saturday, a select group will compete in the Eastern Relays at the University of Louisville. The meet is widely considered to be one of the most competitive meets in the area, drawing athletes from Kentucky, Tennessee, Ohio, West Virginia, Illinois, Indiana, and Missouri. To participate athletes must meet strict qualifying standards for their event.

Varsity girls lacrosse back in action this week

The varsity girls lacrosse team returns to action this week after a hiatus for spring break and senior trip, with a home contest Monday evening at 6 p.m. against the North Oldham Mustangs.

Following Monday's contest, the Centurions will compete in the BraveHeart Tournament at Sacred Heart Academy from Thursday through Sunday. The varsity and JV teams will be competing against squads from across Kentucky as well as other states.

The varsity team will open the tournament slate against Collegiate on Thursday at 5 p.m. at Horton Field. The Centurions will then play twice

on Saturday at 11 a.m. (Oldham Co.) and 3 p.m. (Mercy) on Brescia Field A.

The semifinal and championship games will be played on Sunday.

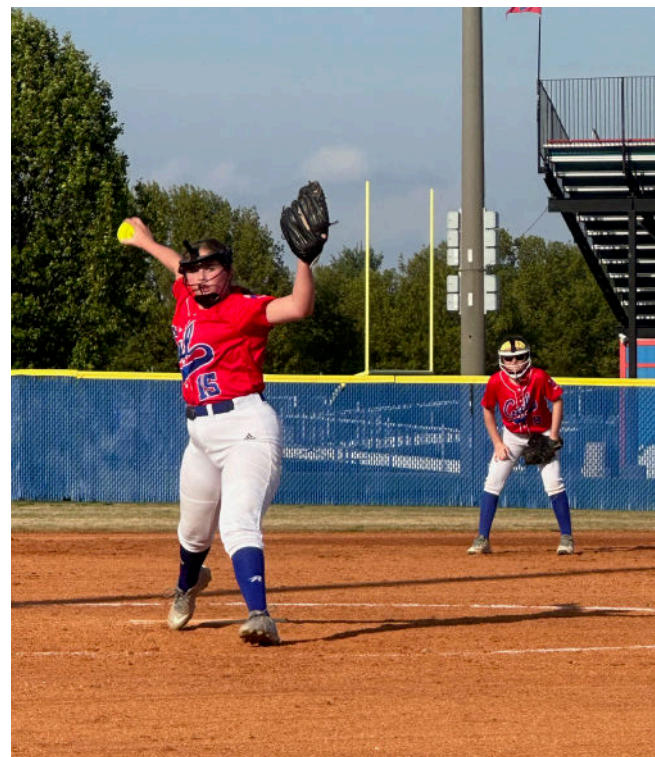


MS softball rolls past Whitefield Academy

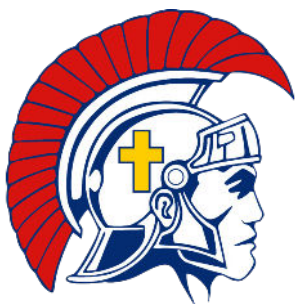
The Centurions play next against LKY on April 23 at 5 p.m.
