Combs started the game for CAL, recording 15 outs. Combs gave up two hits and zero runs, striking out seven and walking one. Eli DePugh finished the game in relief.

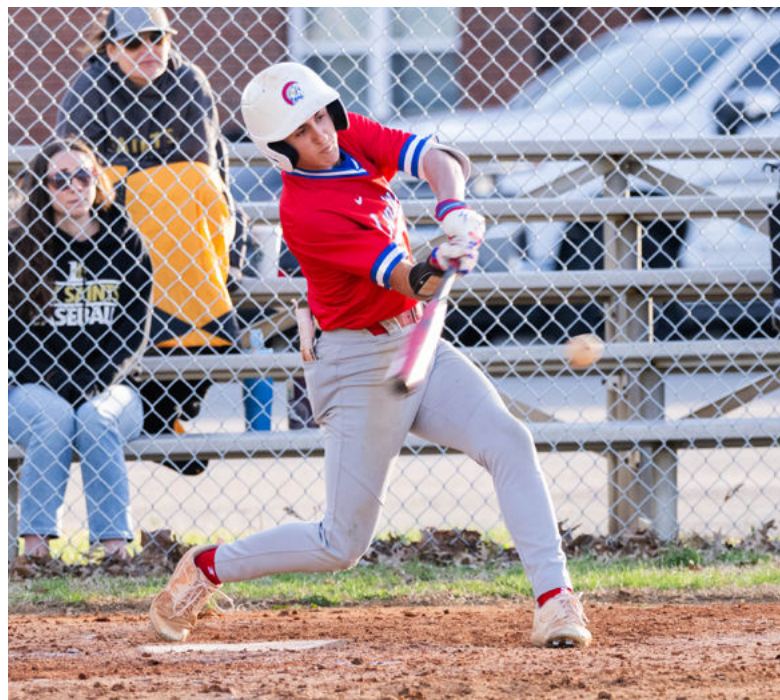
The Centurions jumped out to the lead in the bottom
