Varsity baseball wins four of five

Varsity baseball pieced together a quality 4-1 week last week.

CAL started the week by getting a win against sister school Christian Academy of Indiana.

Tipton earned the win for the Centurions. The right-handed pitcher surrendered two hits and zero runs over four innings, striking out five and walking two. Crawford pitched one inning of shutout ball for CAL in relief. The reliever surrendered zero hits, striking out none and walking one.

Combs, Tipton, and Hale each drove in two runs for CAL.

CAL ran wild on the base paths, accumulating five stolen bases for the game.

On Tuesday, CAL took a loss to powerhouse Ballard 7-1.

Trevor Daugherty took the loss for CAL. The starting pitcher went four innings, allowing five runs on seven hits, striking out one and walking two. Eli Depugh (2 earned runs) and Alex Daugherty (0 earned runs) pitched in relief.

Crawford went 2-for-3 at the plate to lead CAL in hits. The Centurions turned one double play in the game.

CAL jumped out to an early lead in the bottom of the second inning against Butler on Thursday night after Wilt hit a sacrifice fly, scoring one run, and Hale singled, scoring two runs.

The Centurions never looked back, winning 7-0. Haire stepped on the bump first for CAL, allowing two hits and zero runs over six innings, striking out four and walking one. Alex Daugherty tossed one inning of no-run ball for CAL in relief. The hurler allowed zero hits, striking out two and walking one.

Hale led CAL with two runs batted in from the number nine spot in the lineup. The right-handed hitter went 2-for-3 on the day. Tipton and Hale each stole multiple bases for the Centurions.


The Centurion went 2-0 in the Henry County Red Robin on Saturday with wins against Collins and Henry County. CAL beat Collins 11-7 in the first game.

CAL opened the scoring against Collins in the bottom of the first thanks to two walks.

CAL added to their early lead in the bottom of the second inning after Overstreet doubled down the left field line, and Tipton singled to center field, each scoring one run. A double by Crawford extended CAL's lead to 5-1 in the bottom of the third inning.

Tipton began the game









for CAL, allowing five hits and four runs over five innings, striking out four and walking four. Depugh and Durston each appeared in relief.

CAL got on the board in the first inning of the second game against Henry County after Combs homered to center field, plating two runs. The Centurions took the lead again in the top of the third and never looked back.

Combs earned the win

for CAL, giving up three hits and two runs over five innings, striking out three and walking three. No relief pitchers were needed as the game ended in 5 innings.

CAL collected 12 hits in the game. Crawford set the tone at the top of the lineup, leading CAL with four hits in four at bats. Overstreet and Combs were tough to handle back-to-back in the lineup, as each drove in three runs for CAL.

Varsity boys lacrosse wins thriller over Collegiate

Varsity boys lacrosse visited Collegiate last Thursday and walked away with a 9-8 victory in arguably the most exciting game of the season.

The Centurions scored early and often with three goals coming in the first quarter with one by Nolan Seifert and two by Gaines Howard.

CAL continued the scoring in the second quarter with a goal each by Logan Miller and Ryland Adams to settle in with a comfortable five point lead.

But Collegiate scored two unanswered goals to finish the half with CAL leading 5-2.

The third quarter was all Collegiate, however, as the home team rattled off six unanswered goals to end the quarter with an 8-5 lead.

The 4th quarter saw

CAL fight their way back with a goal by Howard to cut the deficit to two, followed by another goal from Adams to get within one.

Nolan Seifert tied the game 8-8, then Howard scored in the closing minutes to put the Centurions in front.

The CAL defense held strong the rest of the way, and the Centurions left with a 9-8 win.

Later in the week, CAL traveled to Woodford County on Saturday night and struggled to keep pace in a 22-4 loss to the Yellowjackets.

It was a promising start, with Howard scoring the game's first goal. However, Woodford County quickly countered with a pair of goals of their own.

Ryland Adams answered for the Centurions to tie things up at 2-2, but

it was all Woodford County the rest of the first quarter, as they scored nine unanswered goals to close out the opening period to take a commanding 11-2 lead.

Nolan Seifert and Adams scored one more goal apiece to give CAL four goals for the day, but WC's offense proved to be too much as they finished the game with a 22-4 victory.

The loss snapped an eight-game winning streak for CAL, which is now 8-2 on the season.


