



Varsity baseball ends week with win Senior night scheduled for this Thursday

The varsity baseball team traveled to North Bullitt this past Saturday to close the week. After two scoreless innings, Logan York reached base on an error to open the third, and Cameron Combs launched a 2-run home run to put CAL on top 2-0.

Combs, Kaden Crawford, and Bradey Moad all recorded a pair of hits and Nathan King added another knock for CAL, but the Centurions couldn't scratch across another run in the late innings.

It made little difference, however, as CAL starting pitcher Cobe Ross shut down the Eagles offense with a dominant effort, giving up only 3 hits and

1 earned run over 7 innings pitched. Ross also struck out eight Eagle hitters in a complete game effort that propelled CAL to a 2-1 road victory. Earlier in the week, CAL hosted Eastern in a 28th District matchup. The game remained scoreless through 2 ½ innings until Trey Tipton doubled and came around to score via a King sacrifice fly to put CAL up 1-0. The Eagles responded with four runs in the fourth inning, aided by a couple Centurions to take a 4-1 lead. Eastern added to its lead each of the next three innings.

Turner's Centurions improved their overall record to 12-6, including a 3-1 record in the district.

CAL will finish its regular season, when it hosts Male on Monday for senior night. Senior night ceremonies will begin at 7 p.m., with the game starting at 7:30 p.m. The Centurions will honor eight seniors: Allie Braun, Bree Emerson, Maddie Furgerson, Tate Hoetker, Megan Mauzy, Bella Osborne, Kayla Woodward and Ashley Zanetti.
