Varsity girls lacrosse falls in state tournament

Varsity girls lacrosse competed in regionals last week, hosting Ballard and Eastern at Centurion Stadium.

Regional games were moved and postponed multiple times due to weather but ended up at CAL, where CAL hosted Ballard on Wednesday.

The Centurions jumped out to a 7-2 lead, but the game was suspended due to lightning and storms, requiring the game to be completed the next night, when they finished off the Bruins by a score of 22-9. CAL was led again by senior captain Bree Emerson, who scored 9 goals.

Later that evening, the Centurions faced Eastern in the Regionals final and fell 18-6 to finish as the region runner-up and advance to the state tournament. The varsity squad had strong support on the draw circle with Saibrin

DeLessio and Rachel Wedding, and Channing Hill subbing in at goalie.

The Centurions faced the top-ranked team in the state, Kentucky Country Day, in the opening round of the state tournament on Saturday and fell 17-3.

With the defeat, CAL finished its season with a 14-8 record.

The week prior, the Centurions finished their regular season at home on senior night with a win over the Male Bulldogs by a final score of 26-10. The Centurions were led by Emerson with nine goals, and all eight seniors joined in the fun, with each finding the back of the net. The Seniors were honored on the field with their families before playing their last game in Centurion Stadium. The 2024 seniors who were honored prior to the game

Varsity marches closer to regionals

The Centurions Track and Field teams are heading into the home stretch with an eye toward Regionals on May 21.

Two Thursdays ago, the teams split up to compete in two meets at once to give all runners, jumpers, and throwers opportunities to hone their skills.

Half the squad went to the Ballard Derby Invitational, which allowed two athletes from each school per event. The girls team took second overall, less than four points shy of Male High School.

The girls spread points evenly across the sprints (Taylor Touche 100m & 200m; Ava Moore 100m; Bailey Duck 200m; Kayleigh Burkhead 400m), hurdles (Ella Mast 100h, Megan Bobnar 100h; Kelsey & Kylie Burkhead 300h), distance (Ava Ward 1600m, Taylor Greenwell 1600m; Kinsley Cordrey 3200m), throws (Ava Moore shot put, Lena Hall shot put; Abby Bassett discus), jumps (Kylie Moore high jump, Megan Bobnar long jump & triple jump; Ella Mast triple jump; Kelsey Burkhead pole vault, Kris-

ten Schlater pole vault), and relays (4x100, 4x200, 4x400).

The boys finished in the middle of the pack with points from distance, relays (4x100, 4x400, 4x800), and jumps (Elijah Dale pole vault). Addison Page took home the top spot in the 50x2 unified relay along with his teammate Hooper Briggs, as well as the unified long jump.

Meanwhile, another group competed at Waggener High School in the 2nd Annual Coach Riley Invitational. Reese Fletcher scored points in the 800m and 1600m as did Lillie Dyer in the shot put and discus. Christian LeSage scored points for the boys in the 100m. Carson Adams and Ryan Watkins threw for points in the discus and shot put, respectively.

On Saturday, a handful of distance athletes ran in the Run for the Roses 3200. On the boys side, Samuel Herbig took second overall out of 73 with a time of 9:39. In the girls race, Anabelle Plummer placed fourth overall.










