Varsity boys lacrosse rounds out 2025 season

Varsity boys lacrosse finished the 2025 season with a 9-5 record.

The Centurions fell 8-4 at KCD in the Fourth Region finals this past Saturday.

Haden Gibson led CAL with three goals in the defeat. Ryland Adams also chipped in a goal.

In the weeks leading up the region tournament, the Centurions split their final four regular season games.

CAL celebrated its lone senior, Sebastian Navarrette on senior night, by beating Louisville Male 19-1 on April 24.

CAL jumped out to an early lead with goals by Nolan Seifert and Logan Miller and never looked back. Leading 5-0 at the end

of the first quarter, CAL then dominated the second quarter scoring 9 goals cruising to a 14-1 halftime lead.

The second half was all CAL, as the Centurion defense kept Male off out of the goal en route to a comfortable 19-1 margin.

Logan Miller led all scorers with 5 goals. Nolan Seifert contributed 4. Gaines Howard and Ryan Brown followed with 3. Anders Hegelson, Eli Snyder, Gavin Gibson and Jax Anderson with one goal each.

CAL lost a tough contest on the road at North Oldham by a final score of 7-6 on May 1, as both teams traded goals all evening. Andrew Masden started the scoring for CAL in the first period, but North Oldham countered with 2 goals of their own.

The 2nd quarter saw a couple of goals by Nolan Seifert and one by Gaines Howard but both teams went into halftime knotted at 4 goals apiece.

Mason Thomas scored the only goal of the 3rd quarter to give the Centurions a 5-4 lead.

North Oldham tied it at 5-5 early in the 4th, but Thomas countered to give the lead back to CAL.

The Mustangs scored the last 2 goals of the game and walked away with a 7-6 victory.

CAL rounded out the reg-

ular season with a 19-4 loss at Trinity on May 5.

Ryland Adams scored for CAL early to knot the game at 1-1, but Trinity rattled off 7 unanswered goals to end the quarter leading 8-1.

The CAL offense came to life in the 2nd with goals from Nolan Seifert, Gaines Howard and Andrew Masden, but the Centurions trailed 14-4 going into the half.

The second half belonged to Trinity, which rolled to victory. Great effort, and we are proud of our team!

Varsity baseball has up-and-down two weeks

Varsity baseball has gone 3-4 over the past two weeks.

CAL opened the week of April 28 with a 10-0 loss to Oldham County on Monday. Oldham County got on the board in the top of the first inning and never looked back.

Depugh led things off on the bump for CAL, surrendering one hit and three runs (two earned) over one-third of an inning, striking out none and walking three. Haire (2 innings), Daugherty (1 2/3 innings), Crawford (2/3 innings), and Hale (1/3 inning) pitched in relief.

The next day, CAL scored a big win against district rival Eastern by a final score of 9-4.

Eastern opened the scoring in the first, scoring two runs.

CAL got on the board in the second inning and took a 4-2 lead in the third on a single by Hahn.

patch North Bullitt on Thursday by a final of 10-4.

The Centurions captured the lead, 3-2, in the bottom of the first after Tipton grounded into a fielder's choice, North Bullitt dropped a third strike, and Hahn hit a sacrifice fly, each scoring one run.
