Ecarma finishes as runner up at boys tennis state tournament

Landon Ecarma made a deep run into the KHSAA boys tennis state tournament last week in Lexington, reaching the finals before dropping a competitive match for the title.

Ecarma, the No. 3 seed entering the tournament, rolled in his first five matches of the week, winning each in straight sets.

Greenwood's G. Zheng offered some resistance in the semifinals after upsetting the tournament's top seed the round prior, but Ecarma dispatched the contender 6-3, 6-2 to set up a championship matchup with Covington Catholic's Alex

Yeager.

Ecarma won the first set over Yeager 6-3, but Yeager jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the second set. Ecarma battled back to even up the set at 5 games apiece. The duo split the next two games to force a set tiebreaker, which Yeager won to force a third set tiebreaker.

Yeager ultimately pulled out a back-and-forth tiebreaker 12-10 – his third such victory in as many matches – to win the title.

Ecarma's run was the deepest in program history for a boys singles player.

HS track & field shows out at state meet

The boys and girls high school track & field teams sent several athletes to compete in the KHSAA 2A state track meet last Friday at the University of Kentucky.

The girls team finished in 11th place with a total of 20 points.

Blakely Touche notched two of the top performances for CAL, finishing third and fourth in the 200m and 100m dashes, respectively. Liliana Turoso also finished 17th in the 200m dash.

Anabelle Plummer had an impressive showing in the 3,200m run, taking third place. Kinsley Cordrey also finished 18th in the event. The 4x200m relay team finished in sixth place, and the 4x800m team finished 21st.

Lydia Wallace finished 16th in the 400m dash to round out the running events for the girls team.

CAL also had several athletes compete in field events.

Abby Bassett led the charge with a 14th place finish in the discus. She also placed 24th in shot put, just behind teammate Olivia Hill, who took 19th place in the event.

Abigail Smith and Reese Alonzo competed in the pole vault but didn't complete a qualifying jump, as did Chatty Thompson in the high jump.

The boys team placed 16th overall with 18 points.

The 4x100m relay team represented CAL's best showing, as the team exceeded its seed to take third. The 4x400m relay placed sixth, and 4x800m relay placed 22nd.

Gerhard Neuner earned CAL's best individual result, placing fifth in the 400m dash. Ethan Fitzgibbon finished 13th in the same event.

Sam Herbig had a pair of solid efforts in the distance races, taking sixth in the 3,200m run and seventh in

the 1,600m run.

Sam Moskovich finished ninth in the 100m dash.

In the field events, Owen Andrews earned a ninth place finish in the high jump, and Elijah Dale finished 13th in the pole vault.

Addison Page had a strong day in the mixed/unified events.

He was a part of the 2x50m relay team that fiinished first and the 2x200m team that took seventh.

Page also finished third in the long jump and 14th in shot put.
