Varsity boys basketball wins 2A sectional title

The varsity boys basketball team won its second consecutive 2A Section 3 title to advance to the 2A state tournament.

The Centurions narrowly defeated DeSales 61-60 in the championship game that neither team led by more than two points at the end of any quarter.

JJ Washington led the way with 20 points for CAL, followed by 19 from Boogie Cook in his season debut. Roland Swan finished a couple of boards shy of a double-double with 10 points and eight rebounds.

Earlier in the week, CAL delivered its best offensive output of the season in an 83-61 win over Nelson County in the tournament semifinals.

The Centurions jumped out to a 28-15 advantage by the end of the first

quarter and never looked back, leading by double digits nearly the entire night.

CAL had five players score in double figures, led by a 20 point, seven rebound effort from Miles Howard. Swan and Washington added 17 points each, and Jack Marrs and Kellan Hall

both scored 10 apiece.

Following the championship game, Washington, Swan and Howard were named to the all-tournament team.

The Centurions move on to play Murray in the 2A state quarterfinals on Friday at Owensboro Sportscenter.



Varsity girls basketball drops close game at Lex. Christian

The varsity girls basketball team put up a spirited fight on the road but came up short against Lexington Christian Academy, falling 52-44 in a competitive matchup.

The team drops to 5-4 with the loss, but there were plenty of bright spots to build on from a hard-fought contest. The team showed tremendous resilience throughout the game, battling back from multiple deficits and demonstrating the kind of character

that will serve them well moving forward.

The game got off to a promising start as CAL jumped out to an early 7-4 lead in the first quarter behind strong play from Kathryn Cline and Livia Quinn. However, Lexington Christian Academy responded with an impressive 10-0 run to take a 14-7 advantage early in the second quarter.

CAL refused to fold, methodically chipping away at the deficit as Cline continued her excellent

shooting and Lydia Wallace contributed key baskets to cut the gap to just one point at 21-20 by halftime.

The third quarter belonged to Olivia Hill, who sparked a turnaround with back-to-back three-pointers to give Cal a 26-21 lead. Her 8-point scoring streak

energized the entire team and showcased the depth of talent on this roster.

Unfortunately, Lexington Christian Academy answered with their own 11-point run to regain control, but the Centurions' fighting spirit never wavered as they continued to battle

throughout the final period.

Cline led the way with an outstanding 20-point performance, shooting an efficient 54% from the field while connecting on 3 of 6 three-point attempts. Hill provided support with 8 points on perfect 50% shooting from beyond the arc, while Livia

chipped in 7 points in a solid all-around effort.

Though the final score didn't go their way, this team showed the kind of determination and skill that will lead to many more victories as the season progresses.
