



Varsity boys basketball places 2nd at 2A state

The varsity boys basketball team finished as the runner up in the 2A state tournament last weekend in Owensboro.

The second place finish is the best in program history for the Centurions, which also qualified for the tournament last year.

CAL opened the weekend with a 56-26 win over Murray. The Centurion defense smothered the Tigers, holding them to just nine points in the second half.

Myles Howard and JJ Washington did the heavy lifting offensively for CAL, scoring 21 and 16 points, respectively.

On Saturday, CAL rolled past Glasgow 78-49 in the semifinals. The Centurions started the game hot and never looked back, leading wire to wire.

Washington led CAL with 22 points, followed by Howard and Micah Akin with 10 each. Boogie Cook tal-

lied seven points and 12 rebounds as well.

The Centurions fell to Boyd County 66-57 in the championship game on Sunday.

CAL led 24-23 at halftime but struggled to keep the Lions' potent offense at bay after the break.

Washington was the only Centurion to finish in double figures with 22

points.

Following the game, Washington, Howard and Cook were named to the all-tournament team.

CAL will be back in action this week when they host Kentucky Country Day for their first district game of the season on Tuesday, then travel to Central on Friday.

Fast start sends varsity girls basketball past LKY

Last Tuesday, the varsity girls basketball team delivered an impressive 51-40 home victory over LKY, improving their record to 6-4.

The team showcased balanced scoring and strong defensive pressure throughout the contest, building a commanding lead early and maintaining control despite a spirited fourth-quarter comeback attempt by their opponents.

The game began with CAL establishing immediate dominance, as Lydia Wallace opened the scoring and helped fuel an early 17-10 first-quarter advantage. Wallace led the way in the opening period with 5 points, with several other players contributing offensively.

The second quarter belonged to Kathryn Cline, who found her rhythm with 4 points in the period, including a crucial three-pointer that extended CAL's lead to 27-13 at halftime.

Reagan Wahl also made her presence felt early, shooting an efficient 4-for-6 from the field (67%) and contributing eight solid points.

CAL continued its strong play in the third quarter, stretching their advantage to 37-19 behind consistent scoring from multiple players.

However, the fourth quarter presented a test as LKY mounted a determined rally, using a combination of three-pointers and free throws to close the gap significantly. LKY's hot shooting brought them as close as five points, but Cline delivered a spectacular performance in crunch time to squash the comeback attempt. She finished with a game-high 20 points on 8-of-18 shooting. Her clutch fourth-quarter scoring, including back-to-back field goals and perfect free throw shooting down the stretch, sealed the victory for CAL.

Livie Quinn provided valuable support with 9 points and perfect free throw shooting (2-2), while Wallace chipped in 7 points to round out a well-balanced team effort that showcased both offensive execution and mental toughness under pressure.
