## Varsity boys basketball beats two district opponents

The varsity boys basketball went 3-0 last week, including a pair of wins against 28th District competition.

The Centurions opened the week with an 83-40 win over KCD on Tuesday.

After a slow start in the opening minutes, CAL surged in the latter minutes of the first quarter to lead 20-10 by the end of the period.

The Centurions caught fire in the second period and scored 38 points to mount a 58-18 lead by halftime.

CAL coasted in the second half with a running clock the rest of the way.

Four Centurions scored in double figures, led by JJ Washington with 18 points. Boogie Cook needed just eight field goal attempts to score an efficient 17 points for CAL.

CAL returned to action on Thursday and beat Portland Christian 91-33.

The Centurions opened the game on a 25-3 run and held a 34-7 advantage by the end of the first quarter.

The Eagles found their footing in the second quarter, but CAL still held a 29 point lead at 51-22 at the half.

The Centurions stayed hot offensively after the break, scoring 42 points

despite a running clock for most of the half.

Cook, Washington, Myles Howard and Roland Swan all scored at least 12 points in the win.

CAL rounded out the week on Friday with an 81-53 win at Central.

Washington and Cook led CAL with 16 and 21 points, respectively, and Will Alvey added 12 points.

The Centurions have now won seven of their last eight games and hold a 14-5 record on the season.

## Varsity girls basketball falls to Mercer County

The varsity girls basketball team put up a determined fight at home against the Mercer County Titans last Monday but fell short in a 52-42 contest, bringing their record to 8-5.

Despite the loss, the team showed resilience throughout the game and had several players step up with strong individual performances. The game started with Mercer jumping out to an early lead, but the Centurions responded with excellent play from Kathryn Cline, who dominated the first quarter with 8 points and kept her team within striking distance at 17-13.

The second quarter brought one of the game's most exciting moments when Olivia Hill sank three consecutive free throws to briefly give CAL an 18-17 lead against a stellar Titans squad. However, the visitors answered with back-to-back three-pointers to regain control and take a 31-24 halftime

advantage, which it never relinquished in the second half.

Cline led CAL with an impressive 14-point performance on 6-of-16 shooting, including a perfect 2-2 from the free-throw line. Lydia Wallace provided excellent support with 11 points, battling hard in the paint and converting 5-8 free throws while adding crucial baskets throughout the game. Reagan Wahl chipped in 6 points on efficient 3-8 shooting, while Livia Quinn made her mark with a three-pointer in the third quarter as part of her 4-point effort.

Though the Centurions couldn't overcome Mercer's strong offensive output, the team showed great character and teamwork throughout the game. The balanced scoring attack and competitive spirit displayed against a tough opponent provides a solid foundation as they continue their season.
