



Varsity girls basketball goes 1-2 at holiday tournament

The varsity girls basketball took to the court for three games at the Pam Browning Classic at Carroll County over Christmas Break.

On Dec. 29, the Centurions suffered their first loss of the season 63-59 to Pendleton County.

Kathryn Cline put together an outstanding performance in the defeat, tallying a career-high 28 points on 9-of-18 shooting from the field. The 8th grader went a perfect 9-for-9 on free throws to keep CAL in the game to the end.

The following night, the Centurions got back on track with a 56-38 win over Henry County.

Five Centurions scored at

least seven points in a balanced offensive effort, led by Livia Quinn with 13, Lydia Wallace with 12 and Candice Smith with 11. Unfortunately, Smith suffered an injury late in the contest that sidelined her for the remainder of the tournament.

The following day, CAL – now down two key backcourt contributors in Smith and Sophia Flynn due to injury – could not keep up with North Oldham in a 61-50 defeat.

Lydia Wallace stepped up and delivered a career-best 25 points on 10-of-20 shooting for the shorthanded Centurions.

CAL will look to rest and regroup ahead of the 2A sectional tournament this week.

Varsity boys basketball goes 3-2 over break

The varsity boys basketball team went 3-2 at a couple of holiday tournaments over Christmas break.

On Dec. 22, CAL filled in for a team that had to leave the King of the Bluegrass tournament early and defeated Lee (AL) 67-64.

The Centurions then traveled south to Ocala, FL to play in the Kingdom of the Sun tournament from Dec. 26-29.

CAL split four games – three of which were decided by four points or fewer – to stiff out of state competition.

The Centurions opened the tournament with a 54-

50 win over Fleming (FL) on Dec. 26. JJ Washington paced CAL with 20 points in the victory.

The next day, CAL fell 44-41 in a battle with Stranahan (FL).

The Centurions bounced back on Dec. 27 to beat North Marion (FL) handily by a final score of 46-31.

CAL rounded out the tournament with a 46-45 defeat to Toco Creek (FL) to finish the tournament 2-2.

The Centurions now hold a 6-4 record entering the 2A Section 3 tournament, which is set to take place this week at CAL.

Schoenbeck named first team All-American

2023 field hockey alumna Mia Schoenbeck recently received NCAA Division-1 First Team All-American honors with Wake Forest.

Schoenbeck, a junior, was also named the Atlantic Coast Conference's Offensive Player of the Year.

Additionally, she recently

competed with the USA's Under 21 team in the Junior World Cup held in Santiago, Chile. The team placed 6th out of 24 teams in the tournament, the best finish in organization history. She is also a member of the USA Women's National Team that will be competing in the Senior World Cup next year.

A change in strategy from the first matchup contributed to a slim halftime lead at 19-17. But halftime proved to be the calm before the storm for the LKY Saints. CAL unleashed a whirlwind of pressure, passes and points in the third quarter outscoring LKY 18-6. By maintaining their composure and executing down the stretch, the Centurions were able to fend off a final spurt by the Saints. When the final buzzer sounded, the scoreboard read 41-33 in favor of the Centurions. In a hard-fought game, CAL emerged victorious, having avenged their sole defeat of the season to secure the championship!

The team finished the season with



a 9-1 record. All-Tournament Team honors were awarded to Alexander Brown, Gavin Ihnen and Jase Norton for their play during the tournament; however, team members Remy Norton, Aiden Cox, Miles Johnston, Carter Lee, Johnny Newsome, Bryson Hamilton and Preston Burge were all integral components of the team's success. The true greatness of this team was evident in the love the boys have for one another and the joy each one showed for the success of his teammates. The team was led by Head Coach Andrew Norton and Assistant Coach Adam Cox.
