



HS boys golf qualifies for state, Judd wins semi-state

One week after narrowly qualifying for the state first round tournament, the high school boys golf team once again earned the final bid to the KHSAA state finals. The Centurions finished third at the second of three semi-state sites on Oct. 1 at Pendleton Hills Country Club.

CAL navigated a difficult course to shoot +23 as a team, three strokes

better than fourth place Central Hardin to advance.

The Centurions were once again led by senior Will Judd, who continued his stellar postseason with another tournament title. The University of Kentucky commit shot a -2 round to win the event by two strokes.

Campbell Parsons (+5, 16th place), Zach Gladieux (+7, 22nd place) and

Jake Elliot (+13, 53rd place) recorded the other three counting scores for CAL.

CAL will round out its season on Oct. 10-11 at the KHSAA state finals at Bowling Green Country Club. The Centurions are one of nine teams competing in the two-day event.

Varsity football dominates DeSales

Offensive precision from opening snap

Christian Academy of Louisville wasted no time asserting control Friday night at DeSales, scoring on every possession of the first half en route to a 62-7 victory.

Sophomore quarterback Jackson Burke was perfect through the air, completing 15 of 15 passes for 218 yards and seven touchdowns, spreading the ball efficiently to a deep group of receivers before resting in the second half. Senior Tyree Stoner added balance with 79 rushing yards and a touchdown on just four carries and also completed a pass for 12 yards.

Dynamic playmakers everywhere

Junior Ja'Hyde Brown continued his standout season with five catches for 149 yards and three touchdowns, including strikes of 25, 30, and 55 yards. Junior Gaines Howard added five receptions for 53 yards and two scores, while senior Micah Akin found the end zone twice on short red-zone completions. Seniors Jeffrey Vazzana and Carson Hahn contributed key catches to extend drives.

Defense turns dominance into points

CAL's defense suffocated the Colts from the outset, holding them to just 138 total yards while registering six sacks and forcing two turnovers.

Junior Micah Newsome again led the

charge with 11 tackles, three for loss, and a sack. Sophomore Kellan Hall added six tackles and two sacks, while Brody Cherry, Britt Dennison, and Jason Hilliard each recorded sacks of their own. Senior Eric Jones intercepted a pass on DeSales' second series, and senior Stone Perkins scooped up a fumble for a 35-yard touchdown return.

Special teams steady after early adjustment

Despite a blocked extra point on CAL's first score, the special teams unit settled in quickly. Freshman Noah Gividen converted eight of nine PATs and averaged over 51 yards per kickoff, including one touchback. CAL's coverage units consistently pinned DeSales deep, with Ja'Hyde Brown adding 56 yards on punt returns to flip the field throughout the night.

Next step

With the win, CAL improves to 7-0 heading into a road trip to face Central next Friday before returning home to celebrate the senior players on Senior Night against Western.

With three straight titles behind them and a dominant point differential, the Centurions continue to look every bit the part of a program chasing a fourth consecutive Class 3A state championship.
