

Touche' swiftly recovered, sneaking the ball into the corner for her second goal, extending the lead to 2-0.

Blakely Touche' soon added to the score. After Addy Schlierf got tripped up by the ball but recovered with determination, she took a step on the ball and it deflected off a Ravens defender and landed at Liliana Turoso's feet. Turoso seized the opportunity, sending the ball up to B. Touche', who dribbled past defenders and sent a slow roller into the net, bringing the score to 3-0 at halftime.

The second half started similarly slow, but CAL remained focused. In a display of teamwork, Hadley Snowden passed to Haylie Springer, who crossed it perfectly to Taylor Touche'. With her left foot, Touche' buried her third goal of the game, securing a hat trick and pushing CAL to 4-0. A few minutes later, Zoey Morgan's quick reactions allowed her to get the ball to Addison Chandler, who skillfully worked it forward. Once in position, Chandler delivered a precise shot just out of the Ravens goalie's reach, making it 5-0.

CAL's midfielders and defensive line were unstoppable, holding their opponents scoreless for the eighth time this season. The Lady Centurions walked away with a decisive 5-0 victory.


