



Varsity football beats DeSales, breaks win streak record

Varsity football set a new program record with its 19th straight win last Friday, a 48-3 triumph over DeSales in the second round of the 3A state playoffs.

The streak dates back to Oct. 25, 2024 and the record that was set in 2016-17 and matched in 2022-23.

In the record breaking game, CAL raced out to a 27-3 lead by halftime and cruised to the victory.

Offense

The Centurions deployed a run-heavy approach on offense, with 18 rush attempts to just 16 pass attempts on the night. CAL was rewarded with efficiency both on the ground and through the air.

Jeffrey Vazzana and Tyree Stoner spearheaded the running game with nearly identical rate stats. Vazzana led the Centurinos with seven carries for 70 yards and a score, while Stoner added six carries for 62 yards and two touchdowns.

Jackson Burke was nearly perfect again in the passing game, completing 14-of-15 attempts for 245 yards and four touchdowns.

Five Centurions recorded at least 25 receiving yards in a balanced effort, led by Stone Perkins and Gaines Howard, who combined for 144 yards and three touchdowns. Micah Akin also hauled in four catches for 47 yards and a score.

Defense

The CAL defense bent but didn't break early, preventing touchdowns on multiple DeSales drives into Centurion territory.

Micah Newsome led the team with 10 tackles – including two for a loss – followed by Jackson Settle with nine. Chapman Russell was disruptive in the backfield with three tackles for loss and two sacks.

Special Teams

Kicker Madden Miller returned to action for the first time since suffering an injury on Sept. 19 and picked up where he left off with a 6-for-6 effort on extra points. Miller is now a perfect 33-for-33 on extra points this season.

Up next

The bracket moves to RPI-based seeding for the remainder of the 3A playoffs, with the Centurions drawing the lowest remaining seed each week.

This week, CAL will host Union County in a rematch if last year's state championship, which CAL won 42-21. Friday's matchup is set to kickoff at 7:30 p.m.

HS bowling gains valuable experience in high-volume week

The CAL high school bowling team dropped a close match to Louisville Male High School 6-5 in a midweek battle. After falling short in five of the six preliminary games, the Centurions stormed back with dominant performances in the crucial Baker matches. Despite their late surge, CAL came up just short in the overall pin count, resulting in a narrow defeat.

Senior Marshall Parrish led the way with games

of 167 and 160. Charlie Behnken added a strong 166, and senior Landon Peterson rolled an impressive 181.

On Saturday morning, the Centurions competed in their first tournament of the season at Kenbowl. The North Bullitt Tournament featured 22 teams from around the region, and CAL entered with high hopes. The format opened with three Baker games to establish seeding for the

round-robin portion of the competition.

CAL started strong, recording six strikes in each of the first two rounds. However, a few costly mistakes and some less-than-perfect rolls dropped the team into the middle of the pack, placing them ninth entering inter-team play. CAL then faced North Bullitt, St. X, and Bullitt Central, falling in each matchup before closing the day with a win over Valley High School.

“These kinds of opportunities allow intense repetitions within the Baker format,” coach Imlay noted. “There’s a lot of bowling in a short amount of time, and it gives players a chance to feel the pressure of competition and the importance of sharpness and focus with each roll. We can’t replicate that in practice.”

CAL Bowling returns to action Tuesday at Ten Pin Lanes, where they will face Eastern High School at 3:45 p.m
