Varsity boys basketball goes 1-1

The varsity boys basketball team split a pair of games last week.

Playing near full strength for the first time this season following the conclusion of football seasons, the Centurions came out hot in a 70-60 win over Atherton on Monday.

CAL got the jump on the Ravens early and mounted a 20-5 lead by the end of the first quarter.

The Centurions maintained their double digit advantage the entire second quarter and led 39-20 at the half behind a combined 24 points by JJ and BB Washington.

CAL appeared to have full control of the game until an Atherton spurt early in the fourth quarter brought the visitors as close as seven points.

However, the Centurions righted the ship down the stretch to pull out the win.

BB Washington poured in a team-high 26 points for CAL.

On Saturday, the Centurions traveled to Henry County for a neutral site game against Oldham County in the BodyArmor Showcase.

The Colonels prevailed 66-65 in a back-and-forth affair to drop CAL back to a game over .500 at 3-2.

CAL travels to South Oldham on Tuesday to face the Dragons at 7:30 p.m.

matches, Bischoff closed out his round with a powerful 29-of-30 pins knocked down in the final frame.

CAL also played matches against Eastern and Seneca last week.

Top scorers for CAL against Eastern were Bischoff with 170 and Bryson Hauser with 159.

Hauser led the Centurions against Seneca with 140 pins, followed by Bischoff with 137. Ryder Peralta also bowled a 133.

The varsity girls basketball team fell short in a 57-52 loss at Assumption last Tuesday.

CAL Brianna Wilkins nearly topped 30 points for the second time in as many games, finishing with 29 points to account for over half of the Centurions' scoring. The sophomore was effective from all areas of the floor, shooting 7-for-15 on 2-pointers, 3-for-8 from 3 and 6-for-8 at the free throw line. Wilkins is now

averaging a team-high 23.7 points per game on the year.

Junior Bailee Duck also chipped in 13 points for the Centurions on 6-of-16 shooting.

With the loss, CAL fell to 1-2 on the season.

The Centurions added a pair of December home games to the schedule, the first coming this Tuesday when they host Frankfort at 7:30 p.m. The freshman team also hosts LKY at 6 p.m.

Varsity swimming competes at Eastern Care-A-Van


Varsity swimming competed in the Eastern Care-A-Van Meet on Dec. 9 at Ralph Wright Natatorium.
