Varsity boys basketball splits vs. ranked competition Coach Riley earns 600th career win

Varsity boys basketball held serve against two opponents ranked inside the top 25 of the state rankings last week.

On Tuesday, CAL fell short at home against North Oldham by a final score of 46-35. CAL made a surge late, but offensive struggles in the first three quarters were too much to overcome.

On Saturday, the Centurions bounced back to defeat Caverna – which is coached by 2002 CAL grad-

uate Josh Pittman -60-54 in the Tiger Classic at Bardstown.

JJ Washington led CAL with 20 points, followed by Myles Howard with 14 points. Jack Marrs was a bucket away from a double-double with eight points and 10 rebounds.

The win was the 600th of CAL head coach Tim Riley's career. It was also his first win with the Centurions. This week, CAL hosts South Oldham on Monday and Central Hardin on

4th grade boys basketballs wins league title

The 4th grade basketball team completed an impressive season by winning the Whitefield league championship, playing up against 5th graders in the highest level of competition offered.
