



## Varsity football beats Bell Co., advances to state finals

The varsity football team took the penultimate step to a fourth straight state title on Friday when it defeated Bell County 56-20 in the 3A semifinals.

CAL jumped out to a 28-0 lead just after the midpoint of the second quarter and never looked back in a rematch of the 2023 state finals.

### Offense

The Centurions once again displayed a balanced offensive attack, with 23 pass attempts to 20 rush attempts.

Tyree Stoner had a monster day for CAL, racking up five total touchdowns. He needed just nine carries to run for four scores and 101 yards on the ground. Late in the game, he also completed a touchdown pass in relief of starting QB Jackson Burke.

Equally impressive from

an efficiency standpoint in the running game was Jeffrey Vazzana, who tallied a team-high 103 rushing yards on nine carries.

Burke steadied another strong day for the passing attack, completing 18-of-21 attempts for 272 yards and three touchdowns.

Four Centurions recorded at least 42 receiving yards, led by Ja'Hyde Brown's 106 yards and a touchdown on eight receptions. Gaines Howard broke off multiple big gains and finished with five catches for 80 yards and a score. Micah Akin showed physical run-after-catch ability en route to a three catch, 43 yard, two touchdown evening. Stone Perkins also added two grabs for 42 yards.

### Defense

The CAL defense turned in another outstanding

performance, keeping Bell County off the board until the final minute of the first half.

Micah Newsome notched 10 tackles to lead the team, including one for a loss. Jason Hilliard was disruptive on the line with five tackles, also including one in the backfield. Kellan Hall made a couple of big solo stops in the backfield to lead the Centurions with two tackles for loss.

Perkins recorded a big interception at the goal line and flipped the field with a long return with the game still in reach during the second quarter.

Bell County scored twice after the running clock was initiated early in the third quarter, marking the first time since Sept. 26 that the CAL defense had allowed more than one score in a

game.

### Special Teams

Madden Miller was perfect again on a busy day, making 8-of-8 extra points for the home team.

### Up Next

CAL advances to play Murray in the 3A state championship game at the University of Kentucky's Kroger Field this Saturday at 12 p.m.

The Centurions enter the game aiming for their fourth straight state title. A win would make CAL the seventh team in state history to accomplish the feat and the second team to do so in class 3A (Belfry, 2013-16).
