Varsity basketball goes 2-1

The varsity boys basketball team went 2-1 against a trio of talented opponents last week.

On Monday, the Centurions traveled to Oldham County and left with a comfortable 75-57 win.

JJ Washington and Boogie Cook led the Centurions with 20 points each in the win.

CAL hit the road again on Tuesday and came away with an impressive 68-67 triumph over top-ranked St. Xavier. The Centurions trailed by as many as

17 points in the third quarter before storming back to take the lead on a pair of free throws by Washington in the closing moments of the game.

The surge was fueled by outstanding defensive play, as CAL held the Tigers to nine points in the final 10-plus minutes of the game.

Four Centurions scored double figures, led by Myles Howard led CAL with 19 points on an efficient 7-for-8 from the field.

CAL couldn't keep the momentum

rolling on Friday in a 68-62 loss to Eastern on senior night. CAL held a 29-23 advantage at halftime, but an early fourth quarter Eagle run proved too much to overcome in a back-and-forth affair.

Cook paced CAL with 17 points in the defeat.

CAL will round out the regular season this week when it travels to Evangel Christian on Tuesday and Jefferson-town on Friday.
