



Braeger wins 200 IM title, full HS swimming state results

Five members of the high school swimming team traveled to Lexington to compete in the KHSAA state finals last weekend.

The hallmark performance of the day came when Kate Braeger won the 200 individual medley for the second straight year. The senior finished with a time of 2:00.12, less than a half second shy of her own school record

set at last year's state meet.

Braeger also finished second in the 100 backstroke for the second straight year with a time of 54.17.

Emme Brooks competed in two events as well, taking 21st in both the 50 freestyle and the 100 butterfly.

Overall, the girls team finished in 16th place with 37 points.


Jack Borruga led

Varsity boys basketball wins at No. 6 J-Town

The boys basketball team rounded out the regular season by splitting a pair of road games.

CAL opened the week with a 63-55 loss at Evangel Christian. The Centurions led at halftime, but a second half push from the Eagles proved to be too much for CAL.

JJ Washington and Myles Howard scored 22 and 20 points, respectively, for CAL in the loss.

The Centurions bounced back on Friday with an impressive 62-58 road win over 6th-ranked Jeffersontown to end the regular season.

Roland Swan had an outstanding game with a team-high 19 points on 8-of-10 shooting. Boogie Cook added 17 points, and Washington chipped in 15 points.

CAL finishes the regular season with a 19-8 record.

The Centurions host the 28th District tournament this week. CAL opens up with Eastern in the semifinals on Tuesday at 7:30 p.m. The championship is slated for Friday at 7:30 p.m.



Varsity girls basketball goes 1-1 to end regular season

The varsity girls basketball team put forth a tremendous effort in a hard-fought 59-53 loss to North Oldham at home. The team showed great resilience throughout the contest, battling back from multiple deficits and demonstrating the kind of competitive spirit that has defined their successful season.

The game got off to an exciting start with Channing Moore leading the charge early, scoring the first basket and finishing the opening quarter with 4 points. After a back-and-forth first quarter that saw multiple lead changes, Cal found their rhythm in the second quarter behind stellar play from Kathryn Cline. The team's balanced attack helped them build their largest lead of the game at 37-26 by halftime, with contributions from Moore (who shot an efficient 5-8 from the field for 10 points) and a clutch three-pointer from Livia Quinn.

The second half proved to be a test of character as North Oldham mounted a comeback, but Cal continued to fight. Olivia Hill provided a huge spark with a perfect shooting performance, going 3-3 from the field including a crucial three-pointer that helped maintain their lead in the third quarter. Cline continued her outstanding performance throughout the game, leading all scorers with 16 points on 7-18 shooting while making both of her free throw attempts. Quinn also stepped up in clutch moments, finishing with 10 points including two three-pointers, with her final three-pointer cutting the deficit to just one point late in the fourth quarter, showing the team's never-give-up attitude that will serve them well moving

forward.

CAL rebounded on Friday to dominate on the road with an impressive 61-8 victory over Jeffersontown to conclude the regular season with a 14-9 record. The team showcased balanced scoring and relentless energy throughout all four quarters, never allowing their opponents to gain any momentum in what became a complete team effort.

The game was decided early as CAL jumped out to a commanding 23-4 lead after the first quarter. Candace Smith led the early charge with 6 straight points, establishing the tone for what would become a thoroughly dominant performance.

The team's offensive rhythm only continued to improve in the second quarter, where they outscored Jeffersontown 23-0 to take an overwhelming 46-4 halftime advantage. Smith continued her stellar play, adding another 6 points in the quarter to reach her game-high total of 12 points on efficient 5-of-10 shooting, including a three-pointer.

Multiple players stepped up to contribute to the scoring attack throughout the contest. Sophia added 9 points on solid 4-of-9 shooting from the field, while Channing Moore chipped in 8 points on 4-of-10 attempts. Brooklyn McAllister was highly efficient with 7 points on 3-of-5 shooting, and Olivia Hill provided a perfect spark going 2-for-2 from three-point range for 6 points with flawless shooting. The bal-

anced offensive attack kept Jeffersontown's defense constantly guessing and unable to focus on any single scorer.

The victory demonstrated excellent team chemistry and depth, with contributions coming from across the roster. The defensive effort was equally impressive, limiting Jeffersontown to just 8 points for the entire game while the offense consistently found good looks and capitalized on their opportunities. The commanding road win should provide great confidence and momentum as the team gets set for the postseason.

CAL hosts the 28th District tournament this week. The Centurions will face KCD in the semifinals on Thursday at 7:30 p.m., with the winner advancing to the championship on Friday at 6 p.m.
