Varsity girls lacrosse off to 5-0 start

The varsity girls lacrosse team is coming in hot, already sitting at 5-0 to start the 2026 season.

CAL opened the season by rolling past Frederick Douglass 17-4 on March 2. Next, they traveled to Collegiate on March 7 outscoring the Amazons 10-8. CAL's third contest was back home on March 12 with District rival Ballard. Once again, your Lady Centurions were too much for Ballard to handle as they chalked up another win by a final score of 16-10.

Most recently, CAL hosted a doubleheader with Assumption High School and Castle High School from Newburgh, Ind., on Saturday.

In game one of the day, CAL took an early lead against Assumption and went up 5-1 at halftime. Both teams netted six goals in the second half as CAL came away with another win, 11-7.

A couple hours later, CAL lined up against Castle with both teams fresh off competitive wins over Assumption.

The Knights took an early 3-1 lead with 6:36 left in the 1st quarter. The two

traded goals late in the period, and Castle led 4-2 going into the 2nd quarter.

A little less than midway through the 2nd quarter, CAL tied it at four all (4-4). From there CAL took the lead and went up 7-6. In the closing second of the half 8th grader Katelyn Mills rattled off a goal with 0:01 on the clock to give CAL an 8-6 lead at halftime.

Coming out of the break, CAL dominated the second half with five unanswered goals to go up 13-6 and ultimately grabbed another win with a 16-8 win over the Knights to improve to a perfect 5-0 on the year.

The team's fast start to the season has been led by several standout performers. Senior captain Rachel Wedding leads the team in goals scored with 17 with 8th grader Katelyn Mills not far behind with 16 goals. Maddie VanAllsburg leads the team in assists with 14 already this season. Wedding and VanAllsburg lead the team with 21 points thus far.

However, the Centurions have gotten contributions up and down the roster, with numerous players making noise both ends of the field.

Juniors Jenn Emerson



and Chatty Thompson have both contributed 12 points so far (Thompson with 10 goals and Emerson with 9). 8th graders Myah McIntosh (6 goals) and Cameron McKechnie (4 goals 1 assist), sophomore Ella Hodge (2 goals & 3 assist), and Junior Channing "Danny" Hill (2 assist) have also racked up offensive stats during the winning streak.

Hill and Eden Copenhaver so far have led the team on the defensive side with numerous caused turnovers and ground balls. Speaking of defense, 7th grade goalie Catherine Taber has stepped up tremendously as a first year contributor. Taber played a huge part in CAL's low scoring victory over Collegiate.

The Lady Centurions will be hosting their 8th annual Ice Breaker Invitational Tournament this weekend; Friday, March 20 and Saturday, March 21. Both Varsity



and JV will take the field with games against South Oldham at 7:30PM Fri., Mercy (JV) at 4:30PM Fri, Manual (JV) 8:30AM Sat., Henry Clay (JV) 10:00AM Sat., and potentially Ballard, North Oldham, Eastern, Manual, or Oldham County pending the initial results. 20 teams will participate in the tournament, so come out and cheer you Lady Centurions on!

Leading the Centurions last weekend was junior Jayden Blandford with a score of 268 out of 300. Freshman Jackson Meek added 253 points to the team's overall score, while

senior Elizabeth Conner and junior Gavin Francis each earned 245 points for the team. Rounding out the top 5 archers was sophomore Willett Brooks with 241 points.

The team had a busy weekend, as the Centurions returned to the Expo Center on Saturday to take

part in the NASP Kentucky Bullseye State Tournament. CAL's top two scores were again registered by junior Jayden Blandford and freshman Jackson Meek who both scored 266 points for the overall team score. Junior Elijah Velden added 264 points to the team's total while freshmen Jax Black

and Gabe Fletcher rounded out the top 5 archers with 263 and 261 points respectively.

The team will now shift its focus on the KHSAA Region 4 Tournament set for March 28th at Mercy Academy.
