Three members of the varsity boys basketball program earned all-7th Region honors via the Courier-Journal last week.

Tim Riley was named the region's coach of the year. Coach Riley led the Centurions to a 19-9 record in his first year at the helm of the program.

JJ Washington was named first team all region. The senior scored 17.9 points per game to lead the Centurions and eclipsed 1,000 career points early in the season.

Boogie Cook was named second team all region after being second on the team with 14.6 points and 5.6 rebounds per game.

Varsity boys basketball falls in district semifinals

The varsity boys basketball team fell to Eastern by a final of 80-65 in the 28th District semifinals last Tuesday.

The Eagles jumped out to an 18-10 lead by the end of the first quarter and 36-26 advantage at halftime.

CAL cut its deficit to single digits several times in the second half but could never work back to even.

Boogie Cook led CAL offensively with 21 points. Will Alvey had a strong night beyond the arc with 15 points on 5-of-7 shoot-

ing from 3. JJ Washington added 13 points. Cook and Washington were ultimately named to the all-tournament team.

With the loss, CAL finished the 2025-26 campaign with a 19-9 record.



Varsity girls basketball finishes as district runner up

The varsity girls basketball team finished as the runners up of the 28th District tournament last week.

CAL opened the tournament with a 73-37 win over KCD in the semifinals on Thursday.

The Centurions steadily built a 35-23 lead by halftime, then ran away with the game by outscoring the Bearcats 20-5 in the third quarter.

Kathryn Cline led CAL with 26 points on 9-of-21 shooting. Livia Quinn and Reagan Wahl added 13 and 11 points, respectively.

On Friday, the Centurions fell 66-39 to Ballard in the championship game.

Cline once again led CAL with 14 points.

Following the finals, Cline, Quinn and Channing Moore were named to the all-tournament team.

The Centurions advanced to the 7th Region tournament, where they traveled to Assumption this Monday. CAL fell by a final score of 77-22.

The Centurions finish the 2025-26 season with a 15-11 record, a significant improvement over last year's 10-22 mark.
