7th/8th Field Hockey Opens the Season Hot

With the sun beating down on the turf at Rachel Baker Field at the annual Crimson Clash, the heat index was rising—but so was the CAL 7/8 offense.

The Centurions kicked off their opening weekend with great offensive pressure in game one and quickly broke through with their first goal of the year. Once the scoring started there was little Collegiate could do to slow them down. Led by Allie Cherry, who netted a hat trick on the shortened game clock, the Centurions got a bit of help later from Skylar Akin to propel the lead even larger and kept pushing the ball upfield repeatedly until they heard the final whistle. Excellent defense never allowed a real threat, and the girls started the year with a 4-0 shutout victory.

Later that afternoon, the sun briefly fell behind the clouds, giving everyone a welcome break from the heat. Thankfully, the performance in Game Two was anything but shady. Allie Cherry picked up right where she left off with an early goal to take away some initial game pressure against a good opponent and when North Oldham found an equalizer, the Centurions immediately answered with a strike from Eloise Fitzgerald, and found a way to close out another solid contest with a 3-1 victory. Late defensive magic and a couple of clutch stops from goalie Evelyn Waggoner sealed the back-to-back wins to wrap up Saturday's action. Sunday brought a new day, and a battle of undefeated teams with CAL going up against a tough Holy Spirit squad. The Falcons built some early momentum with a two-goal advantage, but CAL refused to go down quietly. Ashley Soete put the Centurions on the board finding the back of the net towards the end of the contest, but facing Holy Spirit on a Sunday proved just a bit too much to overcome in a hard-fought loss.

Four games in a single weekend, coming off a tough defeat, and enough heat to melt the bundle of flavored popsicles in a nearby cooler—the girls had every excuse to run out of steam for the final matchup. Instead, they saved some of their best hockey for last. Anchor-age tried to push early, but CAL spent nearly the entire game on the attacking half of the field.

Emberlyn Fitzgerald buried two goals, and Allie put the “Cherry” on top of a fantastic weekend effort adding another one herself as the Centurions pulled away for a decisive win and a 3rd-place overall tournament finish in the Varsity Division.

With a 3-1 weekend record and a hot start under their belts, the CAL 7/8 squad looks more than ready for the regular season to start in a couple of weeks!
