# **Daily Information**

#### Morning Arrival

- All elementary students will be dropped off at the front entrance (door 1).
- Elementary carline will begin at 7:30 a.m.
- The tardy bell will be at 8 a.m. Students should be in their classroom before 8 a.m.
- Parents will be allowed to enter the building only if they have a meeting.
- Elementary students arriving before 7:30 a.m. will be sent to Before-school Care until dismissed at 7:30 a.m.

#### Afternoon Dismissal

- When picking your student up for early dismissal due to an appointment, etc., students must be picked up by 2:15 p.m. Please email your student's teacher as well as the Elementary Receptionist at <u>inelreception@caschools.us</u>.
- Driveline dismissal will begin at 2:35 p.m.
- New Car Tags will be distributed at K-Day/Meet the Teacher Day, August 5/6.
- Parents will not be allowed to walk up to dismissal locations or come inside to pick up their students until after Driveline is over at 3 p.m.
- Students not picked up in the carline will go to the cafeteria for After-school Care.
- All **kindergarten** students will be dismissed at 12 p.m. on the first week of school, August 6-8. After-school care <u>will not be available</u> for kindergarten during the first week of school. Kindergarten lunch <u>will be available</u> on these days.

#### Visitors/Volunteers

- All visitors must enter through door 1 at the elementary main entrance and check-in at the front desk. The first check-in of the school year requires a driver's license or similar valid ID.
- No visitors will be allowed past the front desks during the school day unless permitted by a previously scheduled appointment.
- Cafeteria Volunteers- We can have up to three volunteers per day in the cafeteria from 10:30 a.m.- 12 p.m. This is a great time to see your child and classmates socialize and help students open lunch items, clean spills or serve condiments. If interested, email Olivia Kahl at okahl@caschools.us.

### Chapel

### **Building Safety and Security**



- Christian Academy School System has a task force team that monitors the security of campuses.
