

### College Preparatory Diploma – 24 credits

Initial 22 credits

GPA must be 3.0 weighted

No honors classes required

### Honors Diploma – 24 credits

Initial 22 credits



2 years of the same foreign language

GPA of 3.5 weighted

Three years of honors classes in at least two different subjects



\*Quality points are determined by the most number of classes, highest level of classes, and the best grades in those classes. Study halls and other non-credit awarding classes will affect the formula used in the computation.



# Advanced Placement (AP)

- College level course
- Must meet recommendation requirements
- Must pass exam in order to have college credit
- Great preparation
- \$100 fee charged for the exam

# Dual Enrollment (DE)

- Be aware of minimum GPA
- May be able to use KEES Scholarship
- ACT minimum composite score with a certain subscore in the subject area that corresponds with the high school dual credit course may be required, or
- PSAT minimum composite score may be required in a certain percentile







# Dual Credit Study Hall


- You choose the course and the college
- Be aware of minimum GPA, ACT, or PSAT requirements for college you are considering
- If class is offered at CAL, (i.e. English, Psychology, etc.) you will **not** receive credit on your high school transcript
