LUNCH Hour in between Drama Camps

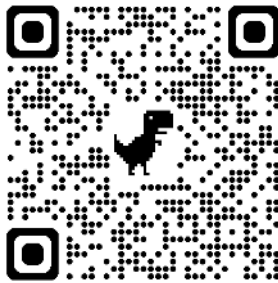
