## A Note from the Counselors:

Hello CAL Families!

This week we are learning about and celebrating Unity Week amongst our Christian family and school system. Unity is defined in the Bible as coming together in peace and is described in Ephesians 11:3 - "You are joined together with peace through the Spirit. Do all you can to continue together in this way. Let peace hold you together."

So what are some activities you can do at home as a family to learn about Unity?

- Bible Verse Relay - Have one person cut a Bible verse into pieces and "hide" the pieces. As a family, work together to find the pieces and put the verse together. You can do more than one verse so each person can take turns being the "hider." You can choose verses related to Unity.
- Oil & Vinegar - In a jar show how oil and vinegar won't mix easily. Get ideas from your student(s) about why they won't mix easily. Then pour soap into the jar (which helps the oil and vinegar mix better). The soap represents how, even though we are all different, the Holy Spirit BINDS us together.
- Cross or Church Painting - Give your student(s) an outline of a cross or church or have them draw one. Then have each member of your family fill the cross/church with your finger prints (with paint or ink pads) OR write your names INSIDE the cross/ church. This shows how we are ALL part of the body of CHRIST.
- Stronger Together - Head outdoors to collect sticks (or use craft sticks). Have your student(s) try to break a single stick and then put the sticks in a bundle and tie with a string. Have your student(s) try to break the bundle. Have your student(s) write John 17:11 "Standing together as one" on a card and attach it to the bundle as a reminder that WE ARE STRONGER TOGETHER.
