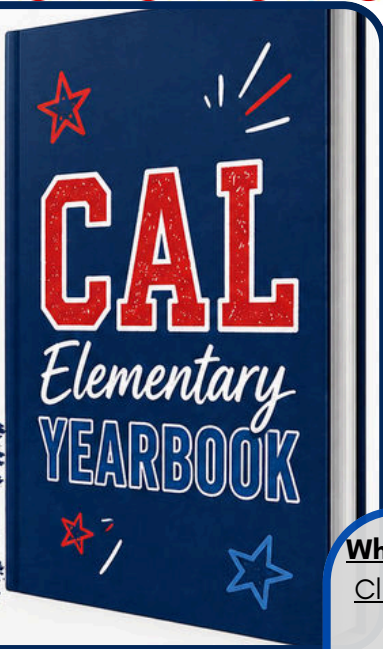

Gospel Reminder for Parents



"You are the light of the world." — Matthew 5:14

However, the Gospel reminds us that Jesus doesn't say "try to be a light"; He says "you ARE the light." Our children aren't just reflecting a set of good manners or a moral philosophy; they are reflecting a Person.

We don't shine our light to earn God's love or to prove we are "good families." We shine because we have already been filled with His light.
