Q. What is a school counselor?

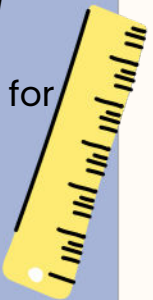
A. School counselors are professionally licensed/certified individuals who help ALL students apply academic strategies, plan their career, and manage emotions and apply interpersonal skills.

Q. Do school counselors provide discipline, therapy, or psychological testing?

A. No, but we can provide resources for these services.

Q. How do school counselors serve students?

- Provide individual student counseling during times of change, stress, or other situations impacting student success
- Facilitate conflict resolution discussions
- Create and conduct social- emotional lessons
- Provide referrals for long-term support
- Collaborate and share strategies and resources for student success
- Advocate for students
- Analyze data to identify student issues, needs, and challenges
