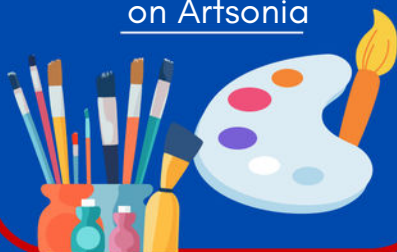
Check out our PTO!

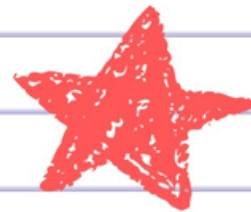

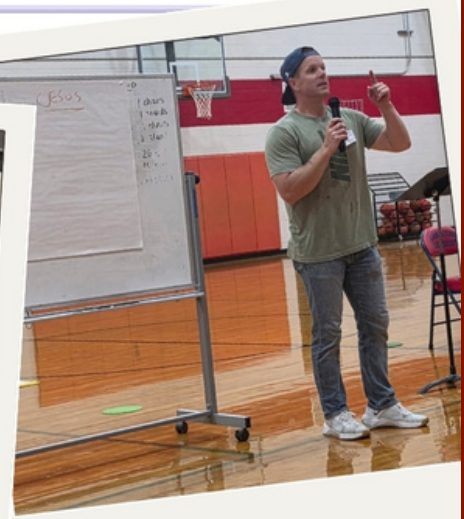
Life Lessons 101!
