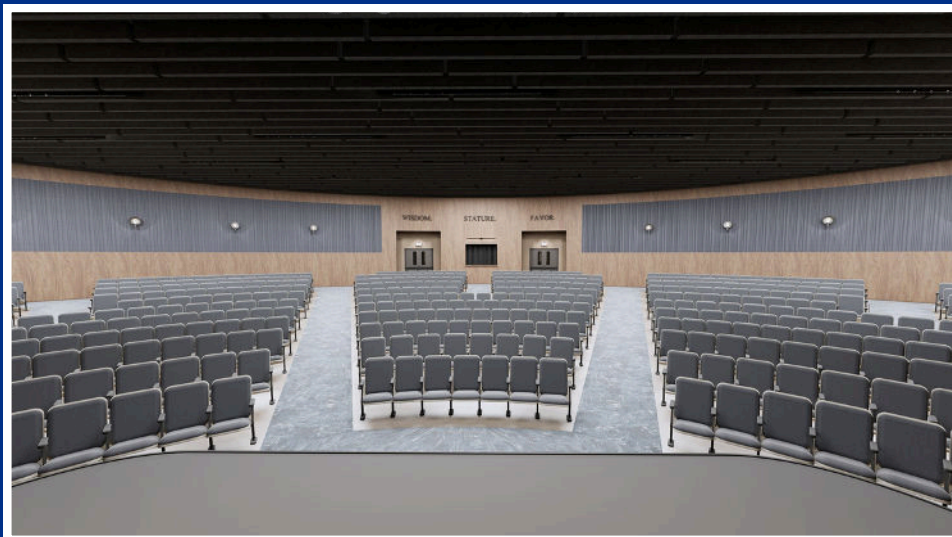

# CAL A THON

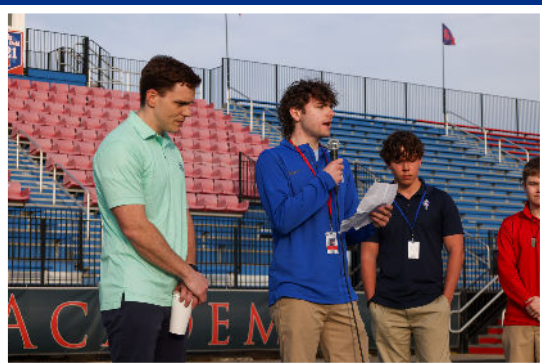

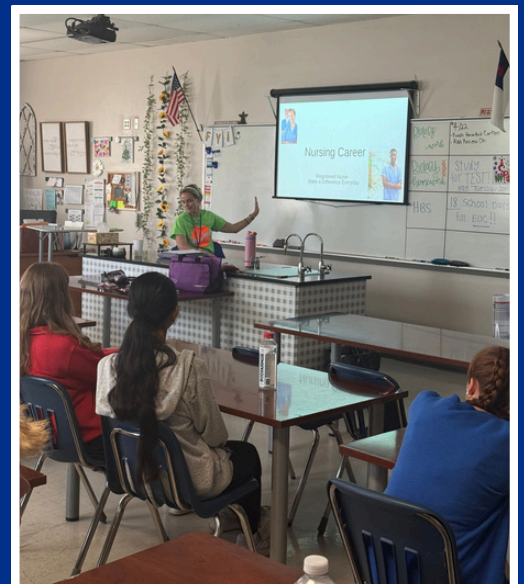




# High School Happenings...

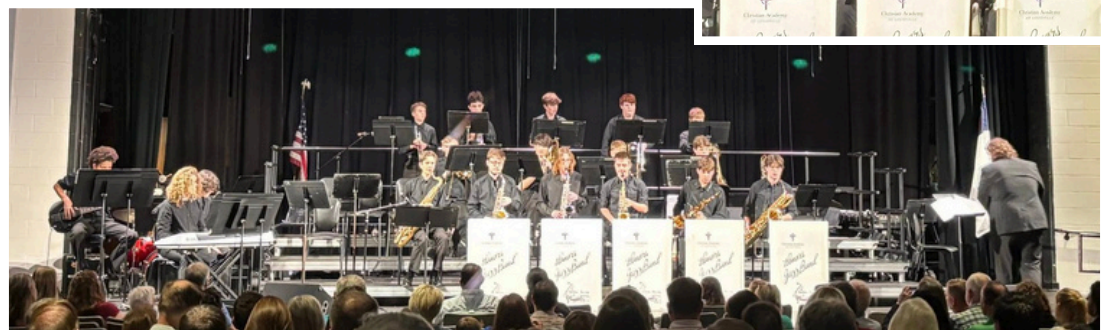
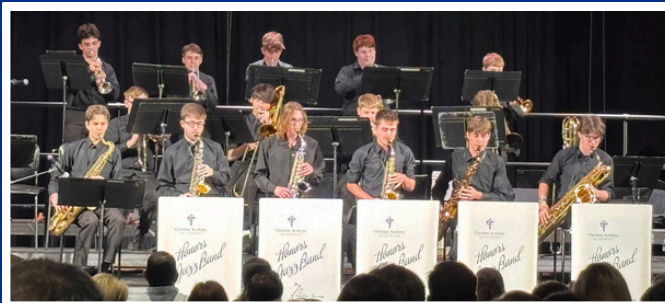

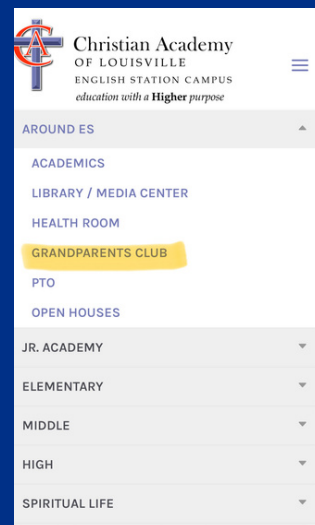
