# **KEES Scholarship**

#### *KEES – Kentucky Educational Excellence Scholarship*

- Each year of high school your student can earn scholarship money towards in-state college tuition
- The High School office **must** have your student's Social Security Number to register for the scholarship.
- The **unweighted** GPA is submitted (A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, F=0).



- We can not honor a request for a specific teacher or to be with certain friends



# Method Learning

- Some classes incorporate program into curriculum
- 2 full practice tests, lessons, quizzes, vocabulary
- Parents can monitor their child's progress
- 20 weeks of activities and lessons
- Quizzes provide the reasoning behind correct/wrong answers

# **Keep List for Resume**
