






- English test scores



AP World History

- Take AP exam at the end of the year
- Taught on the college level
- May earn college credit
- \$100 fee for exam

FOREIGN LANGUAGE



SPANISH

- Start now if you have not had a foreign language
- If you have started, must take 2nd year
- Must be the **same language** both years
- Must have for almost all colleges
- Highly **selective** colleges generally want more than 2 years of same
