- English test scores




# AP World History

## FOREIGN LANGUAGE



- Start now if you have not had a foreign language
- If you have started, must take 2<sup>nd</sup> year
- Must be the same
   language both years
- Must have for almost all colleges
- Highly selective colleges generally want more than 2 years of same


## Sophomore Year
