# **ATTENDANCE REMINDERS**

- All absences should be reported to <u>tclark@caschools.us</u> by 9:30.
- All early dismissals should be emailed <a href="mailto:hsreception@caschools.us">hsreception@caschools.us</a> in the morning and no later than 1:00. Students will not be dismissed after 2:40.
- Students who accumulate more than 5 absences in a class for a semester may face academic penalties. This policy is applied to each class separately.
   Students who exceed the 5-absence limit in any class in a semester are required to file an appeal in order to earn credit in the course(s) missed.
- Junior & Seniors have two College Visit Days that will not count against them for exemptions. Official documentation from the college must be submitted within a week of the visit for the absence to be changed.

# **DETENTION INFORMATION**

Students can serve Detention on Wednesday afternoon or Friday morning. If detention is assigned, students can serve either day, but they must serve the week it is assigned. We will continue to offer Saturday Detention about once a month to allow students to serve more than one hour if needed.

Times: Wednesdays – 3:15-4:15 (arrive immediately after school) | Fridays – 7:10-8:10 (arrive by 7:00) | Saturdays – 8:00-11:00 (arrive by 7:50)

As always, parents and students will receive an email notification if detention is assigned. Please note the date and make sure students are serving when assigned. Failure to serve detention will result in an additional hour assigned...and nobody wants that!

#### Detention guidelines:

- Students must be in dress code.
- \$5 per hour of detention must be paid prior to serving
- Students are not allowed to talk, sleep, use cell phones, or other electronic devices, read newspapers, magazines or novels, eat or drink, pass notes, etc. Work will be provided.
- Misbehavior will result in being asked to leave detention, loss of money paid, hour(s) being reassigned and possible additional disciplinary action.
- Students who have three hours to serve must serve all three hours.
- Students should be picked up promptly when serving on Saturday.
