ACT

All Juniors will take the ACT here at school on Tuesday, April 23, during Blocks 1 & 2 and then be excused from school.

This is an official ACT test and is required for all Juniors at CAL. Counselors will provide more specific information via email.

FINAL EXAMS

Exams are May 21, 22, 23, & 24. Complete details can be found here and we will also provide students with the following Finals FAQs. Parents will receive emails from individual teachers with information pertaining to final exams/projects.

General Info:

- Review Days:
 - o Red Day Classes Friday, May 19
 - o Blue Day Classes Monday, May 20
- Textbooks must be checked in prior to taking the final. See separate emails for guidelines for returning Textbooks and Chromebooks.
- Attendance will be taken during the Review Days. During the Exam Periods, students only have to be at school if they have an exam. If they remain on campus, they will be in an assigned Study Hall and cannot hang out in Elementary, Middle School, Gym, etc.
- Please make sure that you communicate clearly with your child what they are supposed to do during any block that they do not have an exam.
- Finals cannot be rescheduled for convenience.
- International students will be allowed to take finals early to allow an extra travel day. They will need to contact their counselor to reschedule any exams scheduled on Thursday.
- Please remind your child that they need to begin preparing for finals early.
 Students should know if they are exempt and have study materials the day before each block's assigned review day. Refer to teacher emails for specific information on exemptions and exam weighting.
- All fees, cafeteria charges, library fines, parking fines, athletic fees, etc. must be paid and all detention hours served prior to taking exams.

DETENTION

If your child is assigned detention, they need to serve that week after school on Wednesday or before school on Friday. All detention hours need to be served before the end of school. If your child has multiple hours, they need to plan ahead and get them served as we hold diplomas and grades.

PROM REMINDERS

CHROMEBOOKS
